Berkeley County, SC - (July 1, 2020) – The Whitesville Fire Department is pleased to announce that we have received our new Public Protection Classification (PPC™) rating of a **3/3X** which is effective October 01, 2020. This new rating is a cumulation of hard work put forward by not only the Whitesville Fire Department, and the Board of Directors, but also the Berkeley County Emergency Communications Center, and the Berkeley County Water and Sewer Authority.

This is a great improvement over our previous PPC™ rating of a 4/9X and is a testament to our resolve to continue to provide the best possible service to the citizens of our district. If you are a resident or a business owner in the Whitesville Fire Protection District, you will be eligible to take advantage of this new rating beginning on October 02, 2020. Your insurance provider will have access to our PPC™ rating through the ISO website.

About Whitesville Rural Fire Rescue

The Whitesville Fire Department was formed in 1967 and has protected the Whitesville Fire District for 50-years without an interruption in service. It became a 501(c)(3) incorporation in 1985. It currently staffs three fire stations with 52 volunteers and 3 Engines, two 105-foot straight stick ladder trucks, a 100 foot tower truck, an Advanced Life Support Quick Response Vehicle (QRV), five Chief Officer Vehicles, a Brush Truck, two service trucks, one Heavy Rescue Truck, and one apparatus maintenance vehicle. The district is just under 50 square miles.
