## OCTOPUSES HAVE ZERO BONES: A COUNTING BOOK ABOUT OUR AMAZING WORLD IS AN ENGAGING EXPLORATION OF NUMBERS AND FACTS

(May 10, 2022) – How many breaths do you take in a day? How many leaves are on an oak tree? How many moons does Mars have? How many times does a black bear's heart beats each hour? How many meters there are between you and the clouds? How many miles is a trip to the moon and back? How about a trip to Saturn? And what happens when you keep placing zeroes at the end of numbers?

The answers to these questions can be found in *Octopuses Have Zero Bones: A Counting Book About Our Amazing World*, written by Anne Richardson, illustrated by Andrea Antinori, and published by Tra Publishing on September 27.


This innovative book contains scores of amazing and thought-provoking facts that celebrate the numbers zero to nine and power of ten numbers ten to nine billion. Combining elements of traditional and advanced counting books with a sense of wonder and curiosity about the world around us, *Octopuses Have Zero Bones* helps kids fall in love with numbers and the world around us. Geared to children ages 6-9 and their families, the book is a great fit for the home as well as for formal educational settings.

This layered, multifaceted, and fun romp through numbers and facts is accessible at multiple levels, from basic counting to the concept of power of ten numbers to mathematical concepts including measurement, extrapolation, and estimation as well as complex scientific facts. The inviting and deceptively simple illustrations by award-winning illustrator Andrea Antinori complement the writing and are similarly layered. The book's winning combination of math, science, and art provides a range of points of entry.

Author Anne Richardson has worked in the education field for many years, most of them at the San Francisco Exploratorium. *Octopuses Have Zero Bones* began as a project she and her two young children embarked on during the early days of the coronavirus pandemic, and it grew into this book. "In writing this book, I've had in mind families and teachers who are looking for the beauty and simplicity of an artful counting book that contains deeper content for inquisitive readers. I also aimed to engage parents and teachers with a book that they would love to read again and again," she explains.

The book is organized by the numbers 0 to 9 and within each of those, a power of 10 number (1 and 10, 2 and 200, 3 and 3,000...). There are three real world facts associated with each number 0 to 9 and three more examples associated with each power of 10 number. An Author's Note at the end explains the compelling origins of the book and encourages readers to go out and count and measure for themselves.

Octopuses Have Zero Bones is a great choice for the home for its written and visual content, design, and extremely high production quality, which means it can hold its own on any coffee table. It's also a strong candidate for classrooms, school libraries, and town libraries. The heavy focus on science and math along with the sophisticated visuals makes it congruent with STEAM/STEM learning.
