What is UMCOR Sunday?

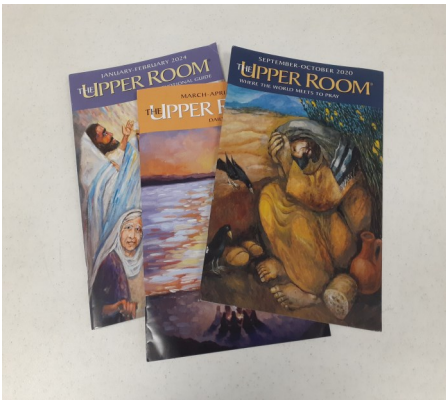

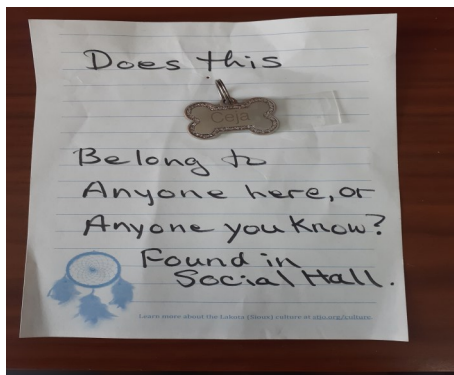


UPPER ROOM

Daylight Saving Time

Spring marks many changes: warmer weather, longer days, flowers peeping through the dirt. But for many people in the U.S, the approach of spring also means the start of daylight saving time. This period—often Incorrectly called daylight savings time—begins at 2:00 a.m. local time on the second Sunday in March, when clocks spring forward an hour. Daylight saving time ends at 2:00 a.m. local time on the first Sunday in November, when clocks fall back by an hour.

Daylight Saving Time, clocks go forward an hour.



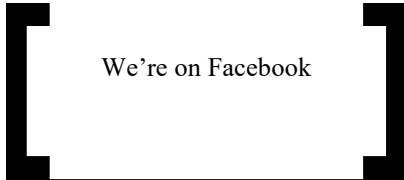
