SAM (Social & Mission concerns) invites you to answer <u>A Call to Action</u> sent out from: 1) UM Immigration Task Force; 2) General Board of Global Ministries; 3) General Board of Church & Society; and, 4) United Methodist Women!

A person makes the difficult decision to seek sanctuary to avoid immediate deportation while their legal situation is in process. This can take months, or even years to finally determine. During this time, to maintain your sanctuary status you must **remain within the church**, unable to return to your home, or live with your family – who can only come see you for a visit. Unable to go back to your job. All meals – there. Any companionship – must be there and is intermittent. No one chooses this as an "easy" answer.

We are called to love unconditionally, with a special focus on those most vulnerable. Postcards & Valentine's cards will be available Sunday, February 2nd and Sunday, February 9th. Please write an encouraging word and let people know they are not forgotten and are in your prayers. Cards will be mailed to eight United Methodist Churches across the country housing people in sanctuary. Let's let them hear from Chino United Methodist Church!
