Hayhurst, S.S. Hill, William Jones, Mrs. Mary Taylor, Laura B. orr And Mrs. Edward Shore: Trutees Charles E. Lawrence, S.S. Hill, Edward Shore, Edwin M. White, and William Jones: Committee Members Mrs. M. D. Herring, Mr. Troop, Miss Cora Shore, Mrs. Lawrence, Mrs. Clara Jones, and Mr. and Mrs. Samuel Jackman. E.W. Caswell acted as presiding Elder.
