- 1 Tbsp. vinegar
- Pepper to taste

No authentic list of charter Members is on record, but the first quarterly Conference notes contain the following names of People who were elected to various offices: Pastor W. White: Stewards W. T. Hayhurst, S.S. Hill, William Jones, Mrs. Mary Taylor, Laura B. Orr And Mrs. Edward Shore: Trustees Charles E. Lawrence, S.S. Hill, Edward Shore, Edwin M. White, and William Jones: Committee Members Mrs. M. D. Herring, Mr. Troop, Miss Cora Shore, Mrs. Lawrence, Mrs. Clara Jones, and Mr. and Mrs. Samuel Jackman. E.W. Caswell acted as presiding Elder.
