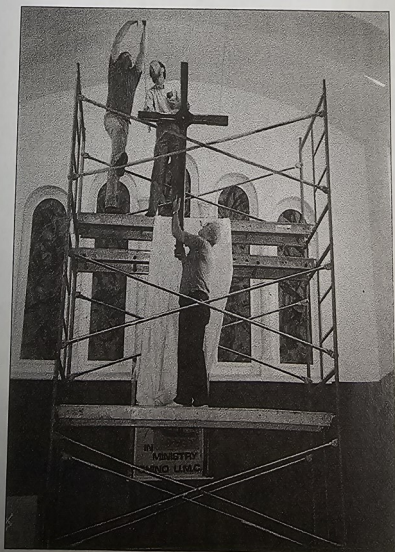

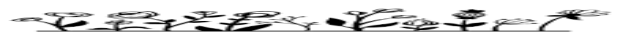
A Little Humor...
