I am writing this on behalf of the M & M Small Group to let you know about a couple of mission projects in which we would to invite your help!

#1 Hygiene Kits

Recently, we took 24 kits to Hope Partners-Ontario for which they were most appreciative. On that same day, we made 24 more kits to have on hand at the church. We would like any donations (Individual sizes) of the following items: toilet paper, bottled water (case of 24 or 36), pocket combs, shampoo,

conditioner, or (shampoo/conditioner together), deodorant, lotion, hand soap, toothbrush, and toothpaste.

#2 Food Pouches

We would like individual servings of the following items: bottled water, pudding cups, fruit cups, cookies, crackers, potato chips, apple sauce and cans of potted meat. If you think of anything else along these lines to add - please do so. We are in need of individually wrapped servings such two cookies already sealed up, or small lunch bags of chips/crackers, and small, round cans of potted meat to name a few.

#3 Food Pantry

We were able to give the food to places like the Neighborhood House and the city food drive which was handled through the Senior Citizens when we didn't know how long we would be under lockdown. A few items have been donated in the food pantry and so we need any kind of staples in there. Items such as: canned fruit/vegetables, powdered milk, breakfast cereal, boxes of pasta/potatoes, soups, etc. Anything will help in this regard.

#4 Shoe Collection for the Neighborhood House

I know that it is only November but Christmas is fast approaching! We collect primarily children's shoes each year. We will take all kinds of shoes. We will end our collection on Sunday, December 12th so the shoes can be taken to the Neighborhood House for distribution before Christmas.

We thank you in advance for any and all help you can give with these projects.
