

We would like your help with the mission projects that are ongoing at church. Here are some Updates we would like to share with you.

#### Hygiene Kits

A couple of weeks ago, we made 25 more hygiene kits which have been taken to Hope Partners In Ontario. They appreciate the kits so much and make good use of them. We still have 25 more Kits at church when people come to the church in need of them. Your donations of water, toilet Paper, as well as travel sized of shampoo, conditioners ( or shampoo/conditioner together) lotion Toothbrushes, toothpaste, picket combs, hand soap, and deodorant. We have found that if you Buy either arid or arm & hammer deodorant that they can be used interchangeably for men or Women kits. Also, when you go to the dentist, ask if they have any extra samples of toothbrushes Or toothpaste and explain why we are in need of them. As has been mentioned before, places like the 99cent store, big lots, or dollar tree are good places to shop for these items.

#### Food Pouches:

We have not had anyone come to the church asking for food pouches lately so we will hold off on That until the appropriate time.

#### Food Pantry

We are ttring to get the pantry up and running again so if you would care to donate there, it would Be appreciated. A few items have been donated so far. Any kind of canned vegetables/fruit, powder Milk, pasta, breakfast cereal, soups, etc..

#### Dolls

The church has been given some 300 18" dolls called Bleacher Creatures. They are dolls of famous athletes such as Peyton Manning, and Jeremy Lin. Some are basketball, football, or baseball players. They are in brand new condition. We are trying to find places for them to go. 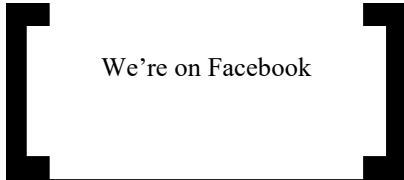
