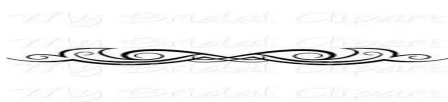

Communion

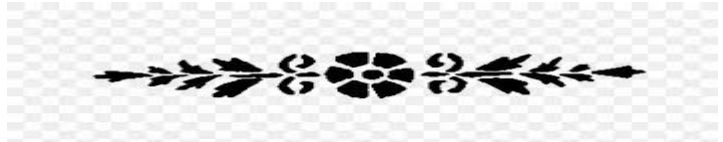
April 7th, was also communion Sunday.

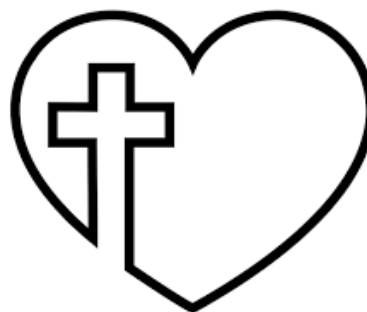
