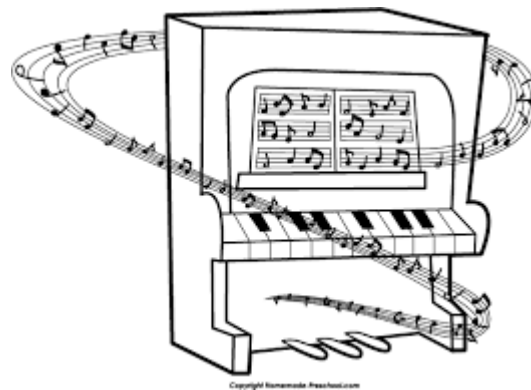
Exciting Summer News!

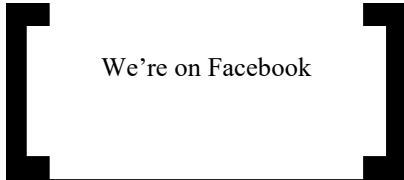
