## Hygiene Kits/Food Pouches



We want to thank the church family for all your support with these two outreach projects. We couldn't do it without you. We continue to hand out these two items to our homeless, low income brothers and sisters around our church as well as Hope Partners in Pomona, and to the Chino Unified School District. We have been able to take 25 hygiene kits a month to Hope Partners for which they are most appreciative. We also receive financial assistance from Saint Margaret Mary Church here in Chino for which we are very thankful.

If you happen to be shopping or you are going on a trip-bring back those soaps etc. that are leftover, we could use any type of donations for either the hygiene kits or the food pouches. For the hygiene kits, we need small containers or "travel-size" items such as soap, shampoo, conditioner, combs, deodorant, lotion, toothbrush/toothpaste, bottled water and toilet paper. For the food pouches, we always need potted meat, chips, cookies, fruit cups, granola bars and bottled water



We make up the food pouches on an "as needed" basis depending on the amount going out and the supplies available. We will be making up 50 hygiene kits during the first part of June. If any of our church members are available, we would appreciate any and all help.

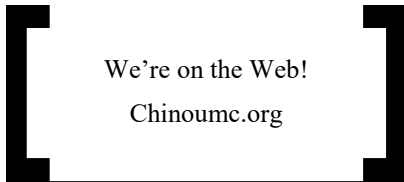
