

HIGH MOUNTAIN HUNTS

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HUNT FOR BROWN BEAR IN KAMCHATKA

(Ursus arctos beringianus)

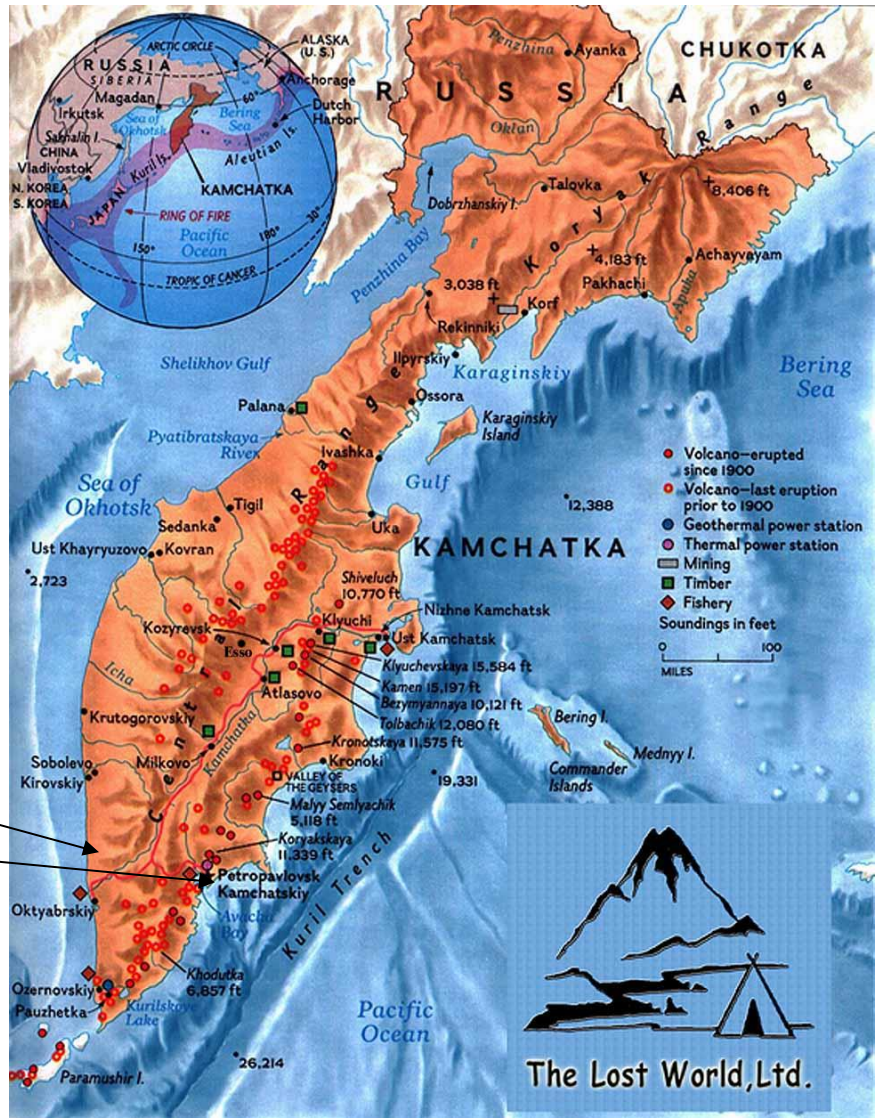
The ultimate experience for any hunter must be a bear hunt on Russia's Kamchatka peninsula. Many years of successful hunts in this region has given this outfitter a great understanding of when and where to hunt these oversize bears. The KAMCHATKA BROWN BEAR is the largest bear in the eastern hemisphere and the cold and dry climate provides these bear with a fantastic coat of hair. Some of the largest salmon runs in all of Russia flow through the areas, this key to the huge bear population and exceptional size of these bear, is this abundant food supply. Many of the bear have skull and hide sizes that meet or exceed the best Alaska brown and grizzly bear areas. Your trip requires flying out first to Petropavlovsk located on the southern tip of the Kamchatka peninsula. Then your party is transported to a camp area by modern helicopter. There is space for up to eight hunters in the hot springs based upscale lodge or private cabins and every hunter will have his own guide. Modern snow scooters to transport the hunters into the hunting terrain. The hunter is taken to ridges and hills which overlook the country side where bear are spotted and when a good bear is found, the stalk begins. The terrain is covered in hard packed snow. Brush is largely covered by snow, so travel is not too difficult. In some instances, it will be advantageous to use snow shoes, which is supplied by the outfitter. The hunt is generally 7-8 days with 2 or more travel days from you home on each end of the hunt
