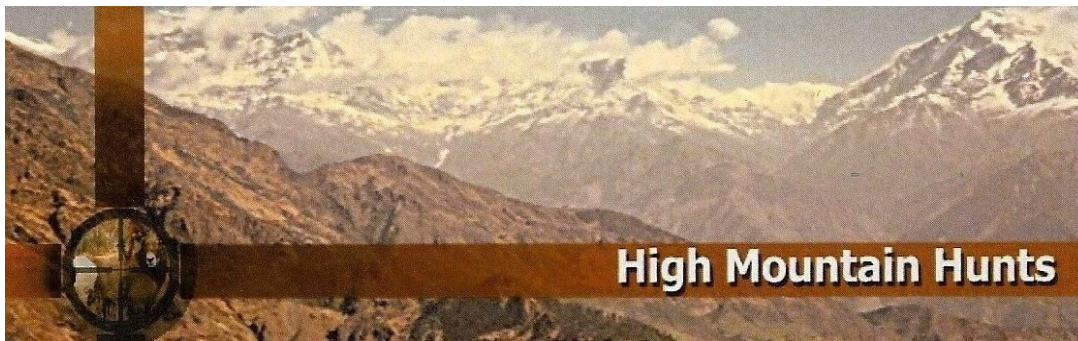

Reindeer hunting in Iceland is a unique and exclusive experience. Every year 20-30 foreign hunters enjoy the privilege of hunting these wild majestic animals in this rugged country. The Icelandic Reindeer was originally brought to Iceland from Norway around 1780. Since then, they have adapted to the much harsher winters. Hunting is based on a draw. Tags for the 2013 hunting season will be around \$1,050. We can apply for tags until February 10th 2013. We need a copy of the client's passport, US hunting license and full address to be able to apply. We do not ask for a deposit until the client has drawn a tag. If no tag is drawn, there is at no cost to the client. We will know the result of the draw before end of February. We can only confirm hunting dates after the draw. At that time we need a 50% deposit to confirm and the remaining 50% at least 60 days prior to your scheduled hunt.

Itinerary:

Day 0: Depart from USA: Seattle (7.5 hours), Baltimore (6 hours), Boston (4 hours or Minneapolis (6 hours) [Icelandair](#) is the only major airline serving Iceland. FYI, do not travel through JFK with firearms.

Day 1: Arrival in Iceland 06:30 in the morning where you will be met by the outfitter's representative. If needed, he will assist clearing your firearms through customs and then drive you to Reykjavik domestic airport (40 minutes). After a one hour flight you will land at Egilsstadir, a small town on the east coast of Iceland. There your guide will be waiting for you and take you to the lodge 10 minutes away. Relax the rest of the day.

Iceland's No. 2 - World's No. 9

Day 2-4/5: After a good breakfast, you will be taken early to the hunting grounds in the mountains. If necessary, you will hunt until dark and then return to the hunting lodge in the valley for dinner. Meals during the day will be boxed lunches. With tags filled early, you may have the opportunity to go fishing for Salmon and seagoing Arctic Char, time and weather permitting.

Day 5/6: Late morning flight to Reykjavik. Transfer to the International Airport. If you depart from the East earlier in the morning, you have an option to stop 2-3 hours at the Blue Lagoon (not included in price). After August 20th, Reindeer hunts can possibly be combined with Greylag and Pink Foot goose hunts.

Included: One trophy regardless of size. Hunting license, weapon license, all transport in Iceland, one guide per hunter, comfortable 4x4 vehicle and 6 wheel ATV for every two or three hunters, all equipment necessary during the hunt, except clothing, firearms and ammo. Full board and lodging from arrival until departure in our new and comfortable lodge with 3 meals per day (richly provided lunch box in the mountains and all drinks except alcoholic drinks. At this time, Visas for U.S. citizens is not required.





Excluded: Capeing, and salting skin and boiling the skull, plus packing = \$280. If the hunter will use a Page 1 recommended Icelandic taxidermist, these charges do not apply. Other items not covered are: trophy shipment, alcoholic beverages, extra days in Reykjavik, international flights and excess baggage charges on domestic flights. Customs clearance, international and domestic air fares, insurance, tips, extra hunting days, extra trophy, hotel accommodation and food before and after the hunt, hotel extras, personal expenses, non-hunter, special food, cost of medications, immunizations, hospitalizations and services of doctors, charges for evacuation or rescue by ambulance, helicopter or airplane and any other service or product that is not agreed or mentioned in this document.

Reservations & Payments per person in U.S. Dollars only: Confirmation will be upon receipt of a non-refundable 50% deposit. Balance is due 60 days prior to the hunt. You must also read, understand and accept by signing the [Terms and Conditions](#), [Release of Liability](#) and the [Hunting Contract](#). When animal parts arrive in the US, supply your completed [USFW Form 3-177](#) to authorities.

Note: You will be supplied with all necessary documentation from the Icelandic government for safe importation into the US or your home country. Purchase of insurance in case of an accident or hospitalization is the sole responsibility of the client. We also recommend the client to protect himself with baggage and trip cancellation insurance.

3 DIFFERENT TYPES OF GEESE TO HUNT:
 These depend on hunting areas, dates and goose specie

- 1) Aug. 20-Sept. 10: Pink Foot and Greylag geese over ponds at dusk
- 2) Sept. 10 – 20: Greylag geese over field in the morning
- 3) Sept. 20 – Oct. 20: Greylag and Pink Foot geese over Fields in the morning
- 4) Sept. 25 – Oct. 10: all three available goose species

Morning hunts. On hunts 2), 3) and 4), we will provide 1 evening hunt for ducks. On hunt 4), there will be 2 evening hunts. There are no daily bag limits on geese and ducks in Iceland.

PRICES: Group of 2 hunters \$7,935



What to bring: 3-shot semi-auto, pump or O/U shotguns in 12 gauge. Warm, waterproof, waterfowl camouflage clothing, warm underwear and knee high rubber boots.

Itinerary: A standard Waterfowl hunting program consists of five days with three days of hunting. For best results, it is suggested that your hunting group consist of 2 – 4 hunters. However, itinerary can be tailored to special wishes if booking availability allows.

Day 0: Departure from USA: Seattle (7.5 hours), Baltimore (6 hours), Boston (4 hours), JFK (5 hours) or Minneapolis (6 hours). [Icelandair](#) is the only major airline serving Iceland.

Day 1: Arrival in Iceland 06:30 where you will be met by a representative from the outfitter. He will assist clearing your firearms through customs and then transfer you to Reykjavik. You will arrive at the hunting cabin in the afternoon.

Day 2, 3 and 4: You will hunt mornings and/or evenings depending on the type of hunt.

Day 5: Travel to Reykjavik in the morning.

Transfer to the International Airport departing 17:00.

Included: Hunting license, weapon license, all transportation in Iceland, one professional guide and a 4x4 vehicle/boat for every two or three hunters, all equipment necessary during the hunt (except clothing and firearms) and full board and lodging from arrival until departure. At this time, Visas for U.S. citizens is not required.

Not included: Fees for extra hunting or fishing excursions, preparation and shipment of trophy according to customer wishes, ammunition (price per 25 shells 1-1/2 oz \$ 28), alcoholic beverages, extra days in Reykjavik, international flights and excess baggage charges on domestic flights. Ptarmigan hunting is by far the most popular wing shooting sport in Iceland and game is plentiful. Only wild birds are hunted. The day's result for a Ptarmigan hunter can be anywhere between 5 – 30 birds per day. This certainly depends on the shooting ability of the hunter, but weather will also influence the result. Of course, the birds cannot be controlled nor can the elements. Two to four hunters will accompany each guide in a comfortable 4WD vehicle.

A 50% deposit is needed to confirm booking. The remainder is due 60 days prior to arrival. Deposit is non-refundable if a trip is cancelled, unless a replacement hunter can be found. We need a copy of your passport, local hunting license and firearms license (if issued in your country) and full address 5 weeks prior to your scheduled arrival. We need these documents in good time in order to obtain a firearms license and a hunting license for you in Iceland.

Food & Accommodations: Accommodations during the hunt are in a new and comfortable lodge with four bedrooms. There are two rooms and a toilet upstairs and two rooms, bathroom, kitchen and lounge downstairs. Six hunters can be accommodated, but the ideal group is four. We serve breakfast, boxed lunch and dinner during the hunt. All drinks except alcoholic are included. Personal wishes of the hunters will be considered in regards to cuisine. When possible, wild game will be cooked.



Itinerary:

Day 0: Departure from USA: Seattle (7,5 hours), Baltimore (6 hours), Boston (4 hours), or Minneapolis (6 hours). [Icelandair](#) is the only major airline serving Iceland.

Day 1: Arrival at Keflavik International Airport 06:30 the next morning where you will be met by the outfitter. The outfitter will clear your firearms through customs (if you want to bring your own) and then transfer you to Reykjavik domestic airport. Then a flight to the East, an

its big glaciers, mountains and rivers. After a one hour flight you will land at Egilsstadir, a small town on the East coast of Iceland. There your guide will be waiting for you with a comfortable 4WD vehicle. The drive to the lodge takes 10 minutes. You may then rest in the afternoon before dinner in the evening.

Day 2 - 5: You will wake up before sunrise for a hearty breakfast. During the early morning light you will head for the hunting area (10-30 minutes drive). The area where you will hunt will depend on the amount of snow. Sometimes you will be hunting in an area with brush cover, or if snow is scarce, you will head up into the mountains where the ground is more barren.

Day 5=6: After breakfast, you will be driven 10 minutes to the domestic airport of Egilstadir. After a one hour flight to Reykjavik, You will transfer to Keflavik International Airport and you will depart in the afternoon at approximately 17:00.

What to bring : 3-Shot Semi-auto, Pump or O/U Shotguns in 12 gauge, warm, waterproof and windproof outer clothing, warm underwear and preferably Gore-Tex hiking boots. Upon booking we supply a detailed packing list. We can provide firearms, either Remington 870 pumps or Remington 11-87 semi auto.

Included: Visa, Hunting license and weapon license, all transport in Iceland, one professional guide and a 4WD vehicle for 2-4 hunters, all equipment necessary during the hunt, except clothing and firearms, and full board and lodging from arrival until departure.

Excluded: firearms and ammunition (\$20 per box of 25 shells), alcoholic beverages, excess luggage on domestic flights, packing and shipping of trophies, extra days in Reykjavik, and international flights. Customs clearance, international and domestic air fares, trophy shipment, insurance, tips, extra hunting days, extra trophy, hotel accommodation and food before and after the hunt, hotel extras, personal expenses, non-hunter, special food, cost of medications, immunizations, hospitalizations and services of doctors, charges for evacuation or rescue by ambulance, helicopter or airplane, and any other service or product that is not agreed or mentioned in this document.

Bringing back your trophy: You are advised to have your ptarmigans mounted in Iceland. An excellent taxidermist is available. You will be supplied with all documentation from the Icelandic government for safe importation to your home country.

Baggage : Try and keep your baggage weight limit to 50 to avoid any excess baggage charges on domestic flights in Iceland (not included in price).

Insurance: Purchase of insurance in case of an accident, hospitalization or death is the sole responsibility of the client. It is strongly recommend you protect yourself with baggage and trip cancellation insurance.

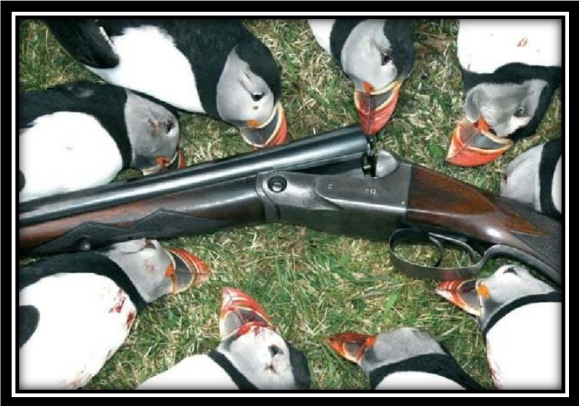

PUFFIN: [Click on this Hyperlink](#) for more info on this bird. You will go out to sea from Reykjavik port in 34-40 foot boats with all modern equipment, a warm cabin and a toilet. You will stay out 6-7 hours each day. A day's bag for 2 hunters can be anywhere between 50-150 birds. The success of the hunt depends on the shooting ability of the hunters, but weather and other factors of nature will certainly influence the results. It is usual to do some sea angling and the catch is mostly cod, Pollock and haddock up to 30 pounds in weight There is no daily bag limit on Puffins and Seabirds in Iceland. The

standard seabird hunting program consists of five days. Two full days of hunting and 1 free day to sight-see. Two or three hunters are taken on each boat. If the group is 4-6, two boats will be provided. Your itinerary can be tailored to special wishes if booking availability allows.

Itinerary:

- Day 0: Departure from USA: Baltimore (6 hours), Boston (4 hours), JFK (6 hours) or Minneapolis (7 hours). [Icelandair](#) is the only major airline serving Iceland.
- Day 1: Arrival in Iceland 6:00 AM, where you will be met by a representative from the outfitter. He will assist in clearing your firearms through customs and then transfer you to Reykjavik. You will arrive at your hotel at approximately 8:00 AM..
- Day 2, 3 and 4: Your 2 hunting day will be chosen according to the weather. The 3rd day will be free or the guide will take you for a sightseeing circle to the most interesting places in the southwest part of Iceland. These including geysers and waterfalls.
- Day 5: Transfer to the International Airport for departure to USA.





Price Includes: Hotel, hunting license, firearms license, all transportation between airport, hotel and boat, one professional guide and a boat with a skilled captain for every two or three hunters, all equipment necessary during the hunt (except clothing and firearms) pack lunch and drinks on board the boat.
