**FREE-RANGE MOUFLON HUNT IN POLAND**



Poland is known for its varied landscape and untouched nature. With the tradition spreading over several centuries, the art of hunting forms a central part of the culture’s heritage. With an area of over 2.5 million hectares available for hunting, no wonder Poland is becoming a highly popular hunting destination. Big hunting grounds, excellent range and quality of wild game attracts these hunters. For over 12 years this outfitter has proudly offered hunting in Poland. With its large population of red deer, roe deer, fallow deer, mouflon and wild boar, Poland



occupies the top position among the hunting countries in Europe. On individual and driven hunts, hunters have plenty of opportunity to see different game species and gain their dream trophies.

The best Mouflon are being taken in the region of Sowie Mountains in the southwest part of Poland. The terrain is hilly with small mountains. Around 100 Mouflon are taken every year in an area of approximately 33,000 acres. Every year at least 10 of these Mouflon are gold medal quality. There are two ways of hunting for Mouflon: stalking or sitting in a blind. Hunters need to have a good knowledge of terrain hunting. Mouflon are very skittish. They have a good sense of smell and hearing, are very cautious and can hide in brush quickly. Males at the age of 6-7 years are ready to be hunted. Best arrival location is Wroclaw (WRO). Mouflon not shot or wounded, return of \$1,100.

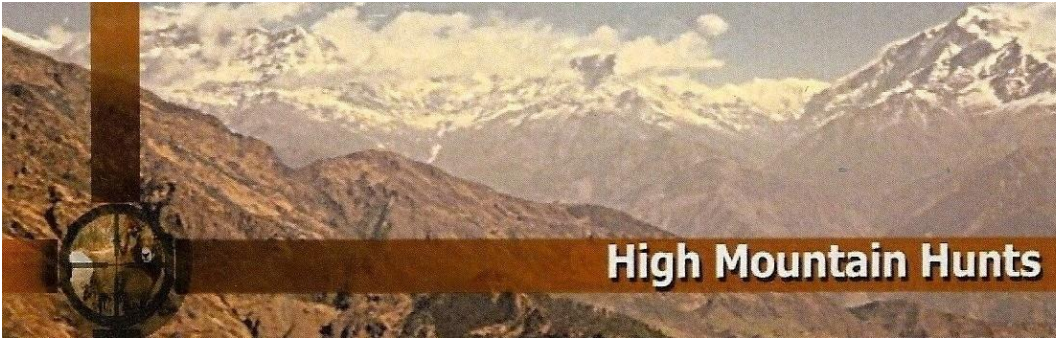

**FREE-RANGE HUNT FOR RED STAG IN POLAND**



Some say that the Red Stag is the king of all wild animals and Poland is without doubt the most important hunting destination for this magnificent animal. The best time for stalking the Stag is during the rutting season, which normally falls in the second half of September. Stalking at this time provides incredible emotions, as it is possible to come very near to the rutting Stag and fights between two competing Stags is common. During this time, the Stags are roaring and stalking up-range for an accurate shot is possible. In the rutting season, the skill of luring Stags by imitating the sound of roaring Stags become priceless. A stag hearing sounds of another one, approaches to chase away the competitor from his territory. It is an extremely successful hunting method; however, a difficult one and requires experience of the guide. Usually time of day for hunting is morning after sunrise and evening until sunset. However, the favorite time for the Stags is a chilly morning, which makes them much more active. The Stags vary in size but the typical average weight is between 4 kg (8.82 lbs.) and 6 kg (13.2 lbs.). Stronger and heavier stags with between 7 (15.4 lbs.) and 8 kg (17.6 lbs.) trophies are found in hunting grounds at north-eastern Poland in

Mazury region and in Southeastern Poland, in the Bieszczady Mountains. Medal trophies over 9 kg (19.8 lbs.) heavy are rare but occur every year in the best hunting grounds. **Stags priced per weight of skull and horns.**

## HUNT FOR EUROPEAN BISON

This is a very exclusive hunt and the licenses are limited and in high demand. Hunting for Bison in Poland has a long, rich and diverse history of traditions which dates to the times of the first Polish Kings. A trophy of bison was a sign of courage and prestige. This hunt was dedicated to very limited number of noble hunters and it is similar today. There are only 20 licenses issued each year and most of the trophies are silver and gold. There are two way for hunting bison – stalking or sitting in a stand. Bison are tracked by very qualified and experienced hunting guides before the hunt starts

## HUNT FOR ROE BUCK

Roebuck hunting is the most popular hunt in Poland. There are two times a year when hunting is the best: at the beginning of the second half of May when the grass is low and in mating season which is normally at the end of July and the beginning of August. At that time the bucks fight and compete with one another going out into open spaces and becoming more visible. Hunting at that time is incredibly exciting. Price includes 4 Roebuck tags, accommodations with full board, insurance and translator service. **Bucks priced per weight of horns only.**

## HUNT FOR FALLOW DEER

Next to the Red Stags, the fallow buck hunting is the most exciting hunt in Poland. The hunt is organized during the rut and is based mainly on locating the rutting stands where stags are roaring. Stalking is done up range for an accurate shot. Usual time of day for hunting is morning after sunrise and evening until sunset. The most successful and most popular hunting methods are shooting from a blind or high seat and stalking.

Quality of trophies from stags varies and is dependent on the hunting region. Typical average weight of trophies varies between 2.0 (4.4 lbs.) and 2.5 kg. (5.5 lbs.) however, there are three hunting grounds where stags with trophies over 3.5 kg (7.5 lbs.) are taken. Price includes accommodations with full board, insurance and translator service. . **Fallow Deer priced per weight of skull and horns.**

## FREE-RANGE HUNT FOR WILD BOAR IN POLAND

The best time to hunt Wild Boar is in November, December and January just before a full moon. At that time, they are hunted at night under the full moon. Wild Boar hunting can be combined with individual hunting of any other species. They are in the run in August. Price includes accommodations with full board, insurance and translator service.

**Tips** It is a custom to tip your stalker, translator, kitchen staff. Tips are accepted in USD.

Your hunting guide during individual hunt 100 euro or \$100 or more

Kitchen staff 50 euro from the group or more(\$70-\$80)

Translator 50 euro from the group or more (\$70-\$80)

**Electronics-** in Poland the power is 230-240 volts, you will need EU type adaptor

**Hunting accessories** – it’s illegal in Poland to hunt with a silencer on a weapon and a night-vision device. If you chose to bring your own rifle to Poland, you have to apply to Polish Embassy first.

**Money** – Currency in Poland is Polish zloty (1 USD=3,5 PLN). In most places Visa and Master cards are accepted. Dollars are not accepted in most shops. You can ask your pilot/guide to help with money exchange in local exchange places or in the city center. The exchange rate at the airport is quite low. Changing at the airport is not recommended. The exchange will be 20-30% lower.
