HUNT EASTERN CAUCASUS (DAGESTAN) TUR IN AZERBAIJAN

(Capri cylindricornis)
 Azerbaijan is the best destination for Dagestan Tur. This stalking hunt is done on steep Caucas Mountains at altitudes between 8,500' and 10,000'. Clients, accompanied by their guides, hike 3-4 hours from the base camp to the tented fly camp and stay there until the trophy is taken. In some places, it is possible to use horses, however, hunters should be in good physical condition for this hunt.

PRICE INCLUDES: one trophy of any size, hunting license, veterinary certificate, accommodations and food in the hunting area, interpreter, 2 local guides, generator in base camp, and all services from/to Baku airport (GYD)

PRICE DOES NOT INCLUDE: international flight to Baku (GYD), visa fee of \$25, rental of firearm at \$300, hotel & meals in Baku before and after the hunt, gratuities (minimum of 10% of the hunt price), excessive weight, international official veterinary certificate \$200, CITES III cost at \$500, special food, cost of medications, immunizations, hospitalizations and services of doctors, charges for evacuation or rescue by ambulance, helicopter or airplane and any other service or product that is not agreed or mentioned in this document.

RESERVATIONS & PAYMENTS PER PERSON IN U.S. DOLLARS ONLY: Confirmation will be upon receipt of a 50% deposit to hold the hunt dates. The balance is to be paid 30 days before the hunt. You must also read, understand and accept by signing the [Terms and Conditions](#), [Release of Liability](#) and the [Hunting Contract](#).



REFUND: if there is no opportunity to get a Tur, the hunter will get a \$2,000 refund unless: 1). he quits the hunt for bad health reasons, 2). if he returns to the main camp earlier than 5 days, 3). if he misses his trophy 3 times, 4). he wounds an animal and it cannot be found or 5). if he refuses to follow his guide to a shooting position. Any size trophy must be paid for.

TRAVEL: Fly to Baku (GYD) to Istanbul. Spend the night in Baku. Travel to hunting area via car, truck, and return. Upon entry into the U.S. with a trophy, present to authorities your [Wildlife Declaration Form 3-177](#) and since the Tur is now on the CITES III list, this means that you will need a permit from the country of origin (Azerbaijan) before you can import the animal. ***We advise that you do not travel through London with a firearm. All clients must comply with the U.S. Department of the Interior/Fish and Wildlife Services laws, requirements and conditions.

Itinerary:

- Day 1 Arrival in Baku via Istanbul or Frankfurt – overnight in Baku not included
 Direct flights from JFK to Baku via Azerbaijan Airlines-overnight in Baku not included
- Day 2 Transfer to Base Camp – 5-6 hours
- Day 3-7 Hunt Days
- Day 8 Return to Baku – overnight not included
- Day 9 Depart for home
