

HIGH MOUNTAIN HUNTS

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DAGESTAN TUR IN AZERBAIJAN

(Capri cylindricornis)

Tur live at altitudes between 7,000' and 10,000'. They are considered by many to be the cross between the wild sheep and mountain goats. This is one of the most prized species in mountain hunting and is a CITES III animal. Dagestan Tur hunting is considered to be one of the most difficult mountain hunts. East-Caucasian Tur is included both in Capra and OVIS Slams that's why it is very important as a mountain trophy. This outfitter can accept groups from 1 to 4 hunters at the same time. The base camp is in a big house with hot and cold running water. You will rest there while the guides take care of your trophy and prepare for further transportation.

Hunter receives a **refund** if he does not see a Tur at a distance of 300 meters, or less; if there is extensive fog, snow, or strong rain that prevents him from taking his Tur unless he has bad health and can not continue, unless he returns to the main camp earlier than 5 days for his personal reasons, or if he refuses to follow his guides to hunt for the Tur. No refund will be given for wounded animals. They are paid for in full.

PRICE INCLUDES: Meeting and Customs clearance at Baku Heydar Alieyev International Airport (GYD), import/export permits for weapon, all transfers and ground transportation during hunting trip, all meals, interpreter, hunting permits and licenses, entry fee to hunting areas, horses (when required), accommodation in hunting house (electricity, hot shower, restroom), tents for fly camp (but we advise that the hunter bring his own tent), unlimited quantity of meals during hunting period, nonalcoholic drinks and alcohol in moderation, professional cook, 2 guides per hunter, export permit for trophy export from Baku, skinning and field preparation, banquet in national restaurant on last day in Baku.

PRICE DOES NOT INCLUDE: international flight to Baku (GYD), visa fee of \$150 per person (please include with deposit), rental of firearm at \$250 (please include with deposit) plus bullets (Russian Rifle-Tigr with optics, hotel in Baku before and after the hunt, meals before and after the hunt in Baku, gratuities, excessive weight on airplane, early departure (\$200), international official veterinary certificate \$200, CITES III cost at \$600, special food, cost of medications, immunizations, hospitalizations and services of doctors, charges for evacuation or rescue by ambulance, helicopter or airplane and any other service or product that is not agreed or mentioned in this document.. Helicopter from Baku to mountains and back an option at the expense of client.

RESERVATIONS & PAYMENTS PER PERSON IN U.S. DOLLARS ONLY: Confirmation will be upon receipt of a 50% deposit to hold the hunt dates. The balance is to be paid 30 days before the hunt. You must also read, understand and accept by signing the <u>Terms and Conditions</u>, <u>Release of Liability and the Hunting Contract</u>.

TRAVEL: Fly to Baku (GYD) through Istanbul. Spend the night in Baku. Travel to hunting area via car, truck, and return. Since the Tur is now on the CITES III list, this means that you will need a permit from the country of origin (Azerbaijan) before you can ship the trophy.

***We advise that you do not travel through London with a firearm.

You must ship your trophy to the U.S.A. and all clients must comply with the U.S. Department of the Interior/Fish and Wildlife Services laws, requirements and conditions. (Dec.2017, 14.15 & 23.15 (c) (1)

Day 2 – Transfer to Base Camp – 5-6 hours


Day 3 thru 7 - Hunt Days
