This hunt has extensive horseback riding and considerable walking. Some knowledge and experience with horses and riding is a must. Physical condition is an important factor in the stalking part of the hunt. This is a classical mountain spot and stalk hunt with spike camping. **Wounded and lost animal – no refund** Bring your own sleeping bag, spotting scope with tripod, field thermos and trophy bag.





Price Includes: visa support documents; guide per every group or camp; gun import permit, local vet certificates; transportation from domestic airport to/from the hunting region and in the area itself; accommodation and meals in camp during the hunt: PH; trophy fees; all serving staff in camp; trophy field care. Agent-interpreter will meet you at Moscow Airport where you will spend the night (hotel accommodations not included). You will then fly to Mineralny

Vody airport in southern Russia.


Day 11 Return to Mineralyn Vody or Cherkessk, stay overnight at the local hotel

Sometimes they are used for transfer to camp and for transportation around the hunting area where possible. Physical condition is an important factor in the stalking part of the hunt.






HIGH MOUNTAIN HUNTS Kuban (West-Caucasian) and Mid-Caucasian Tur
