**HUNT IN ALASKA**  
**For BLACK BEAR, BROWN BEAR, MOUNTAIN GOATS,**  
**MOOSE, SITKA BLACKTAIL DEER**

This outfitter has two hunting camps. One located near management areas 6, 11 and 13 near Cordova, Alaska and the other located in game management area 8 near Olga Bay on the South end of Kodiak Island.

**Black Bear** have always been plentiful in the Cordova area and in the Kodiak in spring months of April and May and in the Cordova area in August. Our bears are hunted in the snow fields or coastal areas in the spring time, or the high mountain berry covered fields in the fall. As always, we have goals, trying to achieve 6 feet or better, with an occasional 8 footer taken.



With the abundance of a rich food source, the **Brown Bears** naturally grow big. We have taken many 10 feet plus bears over the year with many skulls over 28 plus. At the Tsiu, we hunt Brown Bears April through May and September through October. The Cordova area permits each hunter to harvest one Brown each regulatory year, which does not count against the harvest of one (1) Brown every (4) years, like in other parts of Alaska.

The largest of the **Moose** family, with some of the record class trophies coming from the Cordova area. Over the past 13 years, this outfitter has placed in the top three 14 times in Alaska's



has placed in the top three 14 times in Alaska's APHA/SCI awards program. He strives in taking 60 inches or better with our largest reaching 80 inches. The genetics are there.



His herd of **Mountain Goats** in the Cordova area is one of the best in Alaska, with many clients receiving awards during the APHA/SCI program in the past years for top scoring trophies. This outfitter has have been working with the local area biologist in Cordova scouting and taking census in areas for trophy goats for many years. He strives to harvest Billies 8 1/2 inches or better. His average has been 9 inches or better in recent years, with the largest near 11 inches.

All hunting and fishing safaris are subject to 5% sales tax and an 8% bed tax implemented by the "City and Borough of Yakutat". All license, tags taxes will be collected prior to the commencement of your safari.

The area near **Cordova** has a good population of brown bear, black bear, moose and mountain goat. Some of the hunting takes place partly in the Chugach National Forest and BLM lands under a special use permit issued by the U. S. Forest Service and BLM. How to get there: from the East Coast to Anchorage via Delta, from the Midwest or West Coast to Anchorage via Delta or Alaska Airlines. You can fly direct to Cordova from Seattle on Alaska Airlines or from Anchorage to Cordova on either Alaska Airlines or RAVN Airlines. The outfitter will book your travel via air taxi from Cordova to base camp.

The Bear Camp is located on the South end of **Kodiak Island**. It lies in some of the most prime Brown Bear habitat on Kodiak Island. It is also rich in salmon streams and offers a high density of Brown Bear as well as the highest concentration of Sitka Blacktail Deer on all of Kodiak Island. Some of the hunting takes place on Kodiak Natinal Wildlife Refuge and Akhiok and Kaguyak Inc. lands under a special permit. How to get there: You can fly directly from Anchorage to Kodiak Island on either Alaska Airlines or RAVN Airlines. The outfitter will book your travel via air taxi from Cordova to base camp.
