FREE-RANGE HUNT IN NHENDA MOZAMBIQUE

This concession covers 1,000,000 acres of wild free-roaming land that borders Lake Cahorra Bassa for 60 miles. The area is based in Tete province, Mozambique. The habitat consists mostly of mountain with thick brush, cut through by many dry riverbeds. Mozambique is a place for the big game hunter and not for the faint hearted.

This is a true unspoiled wilderness, boasting unbelievable sunsets over the lake. Nehenda is well known in the hunting community for the biggest crocodiles as well as extremely large leopards. The average size of crocodile is 14 feet and some even stretch the tape to 17 1/2 feet. Nehenda carries a high population of leopards and huge males are taken every season. The concession is also home to other species including elephant, lion, hippo, hyena, kudu, Chobe bush buck, Sharpe’s grysbok, duiker, warthog, bush pig, klipspringer, civet cat, genet cat, caracal, honey badgers, baboons and monkeys. Nehenda also offers some of Africa’s most fearsome predators, world-class Tiger fishing. Best hunting is from May to mid-October, after that the heat can be severe. If you wish to do a safari in combination with tiger fishing, the best month will be September and October. If you want to hunt this area, your port of entry in Mozambique will be Tete Airport where the outfitter will meet you.

Health Precaution

Mozambique is a Malaria area and clients must take precautions. It is suggested that you take “Larium” or Malarone” tablets, with your doctor’s approval.

PRICE INCLUDED: accommodations during the safari, all meals and soft drinks, bottled water and local beers, professional hunter, tracker, skinner and full complement of camp staff, fully equipped hunting vehicle, ground transfer from and to the nearest airport, daily laundry, field preparation of trophies and delivery to exporter, rifle import for 1 rifle, hunting license, concession fee, tax included in the package price.

PRICE EXCLUDES: accommodations and transportation before and after the contracted safari, trophy fees unless specified in the package hunt, all taxidermy cost, shipping after delivery to taxidermist/exporter, rifle hire and ammunition, gratuities to P.H. and staff at hunters own discretion, Mozambique visa, extra rifle import, special food, cost of medications, immunizations, hospitalizations and services of doctors, charges for evacuation or rescue by ambulance, helicopter or airplane, other items of personal nature and any other service or product that is not agreed or mentioned in this document

RESERVATIONS & PAYMENTS: Per person in U.S. Dollars only, confirmation will be upon receipt of a 50% deposit with balance due 30 days prior to start of hunt. You must also read, understand and accept by signing the [Terms and Conditions](#), [Release of Liability](#) and the [Hunting Contract](#). All clients must comply with the U.S. Department of the Interior/Fish and Wildlife Services laws, requirements and conditions.

TRAVEL from Houston (IAH) hunter will arrive in Johannesburg in the morning and will usually be able to connect to his/her destination that same morning. If however, you need to overnight in Johannesburg we recommend City Lodge Hotel O.R. Tambo, It is reasonably priced and you can walk to it.

TRAVELER'S ADVICE: Travelers to Mozambique will need vaccinations for hepatitis A, typhoid fever, *and* polio, as well as medications for malaria prophylaxis and travelers' diarrhea. Other immunizations may be necessary depending upon the circumstances of the trip and the medical history of the traveler, as discussed below. Insect repellents are recommended, in conjunction with other measures to prevent mosquito bites. All travelers should visit either a travel health clinic or their personal physician 4-8 weeks before departure.
