Price includes: guides, lodging; all meals: transportation from/to Hermosillo's airport to the lodge and hunting areas; refreshments.

Price Excludes: Airfare; gratuities for guides; imported liquors (you can bring your favorite brand); hunting licenses; shells;, lodging and meals in case you overnight in town before and/or after the hunt, special food, cost of medications, immunizations, hospitalizations and services of doctors, charges for evacuation or rescue by ambulance, helicopter or airplane, and any other service or product that is not agreed or mentioned in this document.

Terms and Conditions: Non-refundable 50% deposit will

confirm and secure reservation. Balance is due 30 days before arrival. A passport is required to cross the U.S./Mexican border. You must also read, understand and accept by signing the <u>Terms and Conditions</u>, <u>Release of Liability and the Hunting Contract</u>. Upon entry into the U.S. with a trophy, present to authorities your <u>Wildlife Declaration Form 3-177</u>. Have address of your

taxidermist readily available. All clients must comply with the U.S._Department of the Interior/Fish and Wildlife Services laws, requirements and conditions.

The outfitter will pick up the hunters at the airport in Hermosillo. Each hunter will have a driver and a truck with a high rack and a guide who knows the area very well. Hunters will stay at the ranch where there is a chef for every meal. All accommodations have hot water and a satellite phone. Outfitter recommends that you bring your own firearm and says that he will help you get gun permits and licenses and that you will not pay extra for his help. However, if you decide to rent a firearm and ammunition from him, the cost of rental is \$300. You can take your trophy home in your luggage if it has spent 24 hours in the freezer. That is, you must have taken the trophy and have it processed (frozen) 24 hours prior to your departure.

Equipment list:

- 1. Rifle .270-.300 caliber. Should be sited in at 300 yards, you can be shooting anywhere from 50 to 400 yards. Shooting sticks if you have them. We highly recommend that the hunter bring his own rifle. Permit is included in the price. 2. Optics: 10-42 binoculars are good for glassing. If you have spotting scope and tripod bring them. Also, a laser range finder really helps.
- 3. Weather: it can run from as low as 20 ° -30 ° in the AM to up to the 80 ° in the pm.
- 4. Clothing: A warm weather jacket, vest, watch type cap, warm gloves, face mask or balaclava and thermal tops and bottoms. Boots, if you have 200-400 gr Thinsulate it helps ward off cold feet in the AM. Light rain gear as it has been known to rain. Hunting shirts, pants, camp clothes, shoes etc.
- 5. Sun glasses, sun screen, chap stick (very dry climate) Dopp kit, medicines etc., Camera, books, kindle etc. charges for electrical devises. A soft gun case is great for transporting you gun between ranches and on the ranch.

How to get to Hermosillo: to avoid unnecessary delays and complications, travel through Phoenix to Hermosillo. Make an early afternoon connecting flight to Hermosillo. After proceeding through Immigration and Customs, you will be met by outfitter. As of
