SPRING BEAR HUNT IN RUSSIA

(Ursus arctos)

This hunt is for 14 days including to and from base camp as bears leave their dens. This hunt includes helicopter to/from airport in Magadan and is typically a snow mobile hunt but could also include transportation by boat. This is the same bear that is hunted in Kamchatka directly across the Sea of Okhotsk.

\$16,500 per hunter

\$ 6,500 additional trophy – same specie

\$ 400 per day non-hunter

\$ 6,900 Second Bear

A wounded animal is considered a taken trophy

Satellite phones available in base camp at \$3 per minute.

To provide client safety and comfort the camps are well -equipped and have all the essential means of communication: satellite phones, radio transmitters, walkie-talkies and signaling devices.

Hip boots mandatory.

Price Includes: transportation during the hunt including helicopter, snow machine and/or boats, rifle & ammunition permits, invitations for getting Russian visas, all necessary export documentation for your trophy, all licenses and permits necessary for the hunt, services of guide, interpreter, cook, trophy care and preparation for transportation, accommodation & meals in the camp. A CITES Export Permit will be provided.

Price exclude: scheduled air flights to Magadan and back, excess luggage fee, rifle transportation fee, CITIES Export Permit, Hunting License, International Veterinary Certificate, service fee of meeting person in Moscow and in Khabarovsk, hotel/meals/transfer expenses in Moscow and in Khabarovsk, accommodation and meals in Magadan before and after hunt (if needed), personal telephone calls (satellite phone calls from base camps \$3 per minute), passport & visa which must be applied for at least 2 months in advance, expenses, gratuities and personal shopping, trophy shipping cost, and any additional relocation(s) and observation helicopter flights requested by client are not included. Also not excluded are special food, cost of medications, immunizations, hospitalizations and services of doctors, charges for evacuation or rescue by ambulance, helicopter or airplane and any other service or product that is not agreed or mentioned in this document.

Reservations & Payments per person in U.S. Dollars only: Confirmation will be upon receipt of a 50% deposit. You must also read, understand and accept by signing the [Terms and Conditions](#), [Release of Liability](#) and the [Hunting Contract](#). Upon entry into the U.S. with a trophy, present to authorities your [Wildlife Declaration Form 3-177](#). All clients must comply with the U.S. Department of the Interior/Fish and Wildlife Services laws, requirements and conditions.





Deposits are non-refundable. There is exception – when a hunter has found a person to replace him/her for the same hunting tour not later than 60 days before the hunt starts. Deposit can be transferred for the next year (years) In case we are notified not later than 9 months before the beginning of the hunt (unless other conditions have been mutually agreed upon). When moving a hunt, a Client should pay a penalty \$500 (deducted from deposit). We can move your hunt only once.

Your gun permit will be waiting for you when you are met at Customs. In the base camp you will spend nights in hunting cabins or two- or three-man wall tents that are quite comfortable and have wooden floors and wooden beds with bedclothes, stove, and portable lamp. Bring a day pack and sleeping bag. It should be light weight enough so you can use it in spike camps. But in order to save space in your luggage you can buy sleeping bag in Magadan (about \$150).
