# Free Range Buffalo

Buffalo and limited plains game are hunted in some of the game reserves that form part of the APNR (Associated Private Nature Reserves). The APNR includes Timbavati, Klaserie, Balule and Umbabat Private game reserves. These game reserves have no fences with each other and are open to the Kruger National Park. They cover an area of more than 300 000 acres and have good populations of resident game, including the Big five. Hunting quotas are relatively small considering the quantity of game that occurs. Thus, hunting pressure on the game populations is extremely low. It is indeed a true pleasure and great privilege to hunt these magnificent game reserves.

## Minimum hunting days

Please note that the following minimum hunting days: Leopard and Elephant hunts – 14 days, Lion hunts – 14 days, Buffalo and plains game hunts – 7 days

#### Price Includes

Transportation from the nearest airport to the hunting area, accommodation, all meals, soft drinks and beer, daily laundry services, services of a professional hunter skinners and trackers, all hunting licenses and concession fees – except Leopard where permit fee is separate, field preparation of trophies, delivery of trophies to local taxidermist/export agent.

### Daily Rate does not Include

Any animal killed or wounded, taxidermy fees, dipping, packing and shipment of trophies, rental of rifle (30 06 & 308 @ \$50 per day, .375 & 458 @ \$75 per day, 500 NE @

\$120 per day) ammo at local replacement cost, charter flights (if you wish rather than road transport), hotel accommodation prior or after your hunt, wine and hard liquor, South Africa 14% Value added tax on daily fees and wounded and non-exported game, , special food, cost of medications, immunizations, hospitalizations and services of doctors, charges for evacuation or rescue by ambulance, helicopter or airplane, and any other service or product that is not agreed or mentioned in this document. No liability is accepted for injuries or loss of personal effects.

## Reservations and Payment

All rates and fees quoted in United States Dollars. A deposit of 50<sup>^</sup> of the total daily rate is required to confirm a book, payment in cash, travelers cheques or wire transfer. Balance is payable before the commence of the Safari. All animals hunted or wounded are to be paid in full on the last day of the hunt. Payment in cash or travelers cheques. You must also read, understand and accept by signing the <a href="Terms and Conditions">Terms and Conditions</a>, <a href="Release of Liability">Release of Liability</a> and <a href="the Hunting Contract">the Hunting Contract</a>.

**NOTES:** Upon entry into the U.S. with a trophy or animal parts, present to authorities your <u>Wildlife Declaration Form</u>

3-177. All clients must comply with the U.S. Department of the Interior/Fish and Wildlife Services laws, requirements and conditions. Elephant trophies in South Africa do not require a CITES Import Permit coming into the U.S.A. <u>USFW</u>

<u>Permit Application Form 3-200-19</u>. (See page 2 of 5 under 1. Enter the quantity \_\_\_\_ (import permit is **not required** for trophies harvested in South Africa).
