MEXICO - CHIHUAHUA GOULD'S TURKEY

Gould's Turkey is the largest of the five North American subspecies. It also has longer legs, larger feet, and larger center tail feathers than other wild turkey. White tips on the tail feathers and tail coverts, which usually separate to exhibit an "eyelash" appearance, distinguish Gould's from other turkeys. The body plumage is blue-green in color and the lower back and rump feathers have copper and greenish-golden reflections unlike the faintly iridescent velvety black of the Merriam's. Hens have a less pronounced metallic green and red sheen and are more purplish in color.

Reservations & Payments: A non-refundable 50% deposit is required to confirm and reserve a hunt date. Final Payment is due 60 days prior to your hunt. You must also read, understand and accept by signing the [Terms and Conditions](#), [Release of Liability](#) and the [Hunting Contract](#). Upon entry into the U.S. with a trophy, present to authorities your [Wildlife Declaration Form 3-177](#). Note: trophies can only be released to a USDA licensed taxidermist or his agent due to New Castle poultry

disease. Have address of your taxidermist readily available. All clients must comply with the U.S. Department of the Interior/Fish and Wildlife Services laws, requirements and conditions.

Price Includes: Transportation to/from Chihuahua City airport, transportation to camp (or hotel depending upon arrival time) two hours west near the city of Guerrero or 3 hours west near the city of Madera, accommodations and food in the hunting area, use of 12 gauge 870s or Mossberg, ammunition, licenses, tags, field transportation, field preparation, guides and translators.

Package Excludes: Airfare and related costs, visa (approx. \$7 at the airport), hotel and related expenses before and after the hunt (if necessary), special food, cost of medications, immunizations, hospitalizations and services of doctors, charges for evacuation or rescue by ambulance, helicopter or airplane, and any other service or product that is not agreed or mentioned in this document.
