## HUNT BLACK BEAR

(ursus americanus)

Success Rate = 80% with 100% Opportunity

Color Phase Bears Common



This outfitter offers five day baited bear hunts in the early spring and fall of each year along the south and east edge of 650,000 acres of National Forest. The areas hunted are prime bear habitat. Platform tree stands have dimensions of four feet by four feet. The ground level hunting houses are four feet by four feet by seven feet high. The large stands make your time in the woods much more comfortable. With the number of stands this allows the flexibility to move hunters in changing wind directions or weather. All stands are accessible by four wheelers driven by staff to the stand location. The stands can accommodate hunters from rifle to muzzleloader to archery. The outfitter gives each hunter a radio transmitter during their time in the stand. A normal week consists of breakfast in the morning at approximately 8:00 A. M. The hunters are then taken into the stands by 9:30 A.M. and usually hunt until 1:00 P.M. You will come back to the lodge where a superb lunch has been prepared and then the hunter gets ready for the evening outing. The hunters are taken to the stands close to 5:00

P.M. and they hunt until dark. By hunting twice a day the success ratio increases for the hunter rather than just one outing a day. This access to the stands for the hunter increases the success for color phase bears which are about forty per cent of our harvest. Careful attention is paid to all of the stands for scent protection and hunter safety. An important factor starting the week is the instruction by this outfitter as to the judging of bears from past photographs and video with the clients.

This outfitter has an allocated area of waterfowl hunting which encompasses thousands of acres of private farmland and countless bodies of water. This allocated area includes private farmland with peas, barley, and oats. The land is prime feeding for the birds which are residents of the area even before the migration. All of the goose hunting is done in the field. Ninety per cent of the duck hunting is done in the field with the remainder done over pot holes or small bodies of water. The early morning hunts start with a light breakfast served by the outfitter. The outfitter then take clients to a prior scouted field in the trucks. There at the field, the blinds and decoys are laid out for the hunt. A typical morning hunt will have one guide staying with the hunters to call the hunt. The rest of the guides will scout out fields for the upcoming days. After the morning hunt you will return to the lodge for a large home cooked meal. Hunters will have time to relax before the evening hunt. In the afternoon, the hunters are taken to the field for an evening of



ducks. At this time all guides will be out scouting and the hunters will call the hunt themselves. The outfitter will supply a hand-held radio to the hunters for contact with the guides. After the hunt, you will return to the lodge for relaxation in the spacious trophy room and then a late evening meal.



Combination hunts are available for both waterfowl and bear in the fall. The bear and waterfowl combination hunt consists of morning goose with late morning and evening bear hunting. After each morning goose hunt, we then take the hunter to the bear stand where they will hunt until approximately 1:00 P.M. From there the hunter is brought back to the lodge for a large noon meal. We allow the hunters the afternoon to rest until we again take them out to a bear stand approximately at 4:30 P.M. The hunter will stay in the bear stand until dark which makes for a full day. After a hunter harvests a bear then they may have the opportunity to hunt ducks as well in the evening for the rest of their stay with us. This combination hunt offers a great opportunity to harvest a black bear and to experience our waterfowl hunting.

Things to bring: rain gear, proper clothing for at least one week, hunting boots and camp shoes, camera, binoculars, range finder, gloves, day pack, valid passport, firearms registration paperwork, choice of weapon, ammunition. Fishing and a day on the water in the comfort of an 18 foot Crestliner is a possibility after the bears are harvested...time and weather permitting. This opportunity is included in packages at no cost other than the fishing license.

How to get there from DFW: Denver to Saskatchewan on United.



**Price Includes:** radios for communication, transportation to/from Saskatoon airport, two outings per day, soft cases for weapons, orange cover-ups and hats for rifle hunters, meals and lodging, Thermacell (mosquito repellant) units.

**Price Excludes:** License & GST (approx. \$161.92. Wildlife Stamp \$10.79), hotel and meals before/after the hunt, if necessary, airfare, laundry services, transportation game coolers, personal alcoholic beverages, insurance, personal expenses, firearms permit, trophy shipment, gratuities, special food, cost of medications, immunizations, hospitalizations and services of doctors, charges for evacuation or rescue by ambulance, helicopter or airplane and any other service or product that is not agreed or mentioned in this document.

Reservations & Payments: Per person in U.S. Dollars only, confirmation will be upon receipt of a 50% deposit. You must also read, understand and accept by signing the Terms and Conditions, Release of Liability and the Hunting Contract. Balance is due in cash at the beginning of the hunt. Upon entry into the U.S. with a trophy, present to authorities the Wildlife Declaration Form 3-177 ( see Google). All clients must comply with the U.S. Department of the Interior/Fish and Wildlife Services laws, requirements and conditions



Please download the <u>Firearm Declaration Form</u> RCMP 5589 and you can either fill out the form and wait to sign it in Edmonton where there will be a \$25 charge or you can prepay which will save you some time in Edmonton by downloading the form and fax the completed form to Canadian Boarder Services @ 780- 890-4309 and include on your cover page your credit card info as well as your return fax # where the authorization can be sent.
