LESSON RECAP

God's people, the Israelites endured some difficult times, even long after Moses was in Egypt. But God promised a Savior would come. So they waited. And waited. Many prophets talked about this Savior that was to come – this was way before they knew that the Savior would be Jesus. Prophets also talked about someone who would come before Jesus, and be a messenger who would prepare the way for the Savior. That person was John the Baptist. John the Baptist traveled and taught many people about God and about the Savior who was coming. . .Jesus! John the Baptist baptized people and helped them get ready for Jesus' arrival. He helped Jesus by preparing the people around him to know that they needed Jesus to rescue them. And just like they needed Jesus as their Savior, we do, too!
