MEMORY VERSE ACTIVITY | Love Bug!

INSTRUCTIONS: Hide a bunch of [cut-out VW bugs](#), each with the memory verse printed on it, around the room. Anytime a kid spots one, they have to grab it, and yell, "Love bug!" When all the bugs are found – make sure each kid has one – say the verse together.

YOUNGER & OLDER KIDS ACTIVITY | Share the Love

INSTRUCTIONS: Find a pillow, and if you have one, a heart pillow. Sit in a circle with your kids. Explain that you are going to play some music as you pass the heart pillow. As you pass the pillow, tell them to imagine you're passing love to each other. When the music stops, the kid holding the pillow has to recite today's Big Idea and is out of the circle. Once they are out, they have to hop on one foot around the circle until they get back to their spot. Continue to play as time allows.

OLDER KIDS ACTIVITY | LUV EVRY 1

SAY: This week we talked about how we obey God by loving everyone. It isn't always easy, but God wants us to be kind and compassionate to those in our family, in our community, our school, and our church. Think about ways you can show love to someone in each of these categories this week! To help us remember to love everybody, we are going to create our very own license plates!

INSTRUCTIONS: Print the [license plate printable](#) on cardstock paper and instruct the kids to create personalized license plates using art supplies. Help them brainstorm and list ways they can show love to someone in their family, their community, their school, or their church. Include some of these items on the back of their license plate.
