WEEK OF NOVEMBER 1ST



Once your family is seated at the table & eating, go through each section below together.

HIGH LOW BUFFALO

Take turns around the table to share your **HIGH** from the day (the best thing that happened), your **LOW** from the day (something that made you upset), and **SOMETHING RANDOM** from your day that you'd like to share.

This week, have the QUIETEST person in your family go first.

LESSON RECAP

This week we picked right back up with Joseph from last week, where Joseph was waiting on God to fulfill His promises. But when God says something will happen, it will. Sure enough, years later, Joseph's brothers came to Egypt to buy grain during the famine. Because Joseph had favor and was put in charge over of all Egypt, his brothers bowed down to him, just as God said they would in Joseph's dream. Though his brothers had tried to harm Joseph, God used their evil plans to do a great good! Many lives were saved - even the lives of his brothers!

THE BIG IDEA: God's keeps His promises.

THE BIBLE: Joseph is Put in Charge: Genesis 40:1-41:40; 45:1-8

ASK THIS

- Read Genesis 45:5. Joseph forgave his brothers. Why did he tell them not to be angry with themselves?
- What are some of God's promises?
- Have you ever experienced a promise being kept?
- What helps you remember that God keeps promises?

NOW WHAT?

The words of the Bible are not there by accident. God meant to say them. He meant for us to hear the stories, listen to the commands, and believe the promises. So next time you're tempted to think "God must have meant something else," remember the story of Joseph and his brothers. Remember that what God says is true. Always.
