This week, have the person with the **shortest hair** go first.

#### LESSON RECAP

When we hear something that is hard to believe, we like to question it. After all, it is unbelievable! That's what the leaders in John 1:19-28 did when John explained to them who he was. But John made it very clear that he came to prepare the way for the Savior (Jesus)! John told them when he baptized people with water, he didn't really wash away their sin – he just helped people decide in their hearts to ask God for forgiveness. But the Savior could actually wash away our sins! John said that the Savior was coming and they should all be ready to receive his message. God sent his Son, Jesus, at just the right time to change the hearts of sinful people forever. This is the hope of the Christmas season... the coming of the Savior of the world!
