YOUNGER & OLDER KIDS ACTIVITY | Ready Prayer One

INSTRUCTIONS: Print off a copy of the virtual reality (VR) headset <u>here</u>. Have kids draw a picture of something they might have to wait a while for . . . like what they might be when they grow up.

SAY: What is something you pray you might have or see in the future? We can pray to God and God hears us and answers us. But sometimes God wants us to wait until the right time. That's what God did with Jesus – God sent the Savior at just the right time to change the world forever! **Wait and see, the Savior will change everything.**

SNACK | Sandals

INGREDIENTS:

- Nutter Butter Cookies (or graham crackers)
- Icing

INSTRUCTIONS: Use icing to create a sandal pattern on top of a Nutter Butter as pictured. Remind the kids that John said he wasn't even good enough to untie Jesus' sandals.



SAY: John the Baptist said that Jesus was so much greater, that John wasn't good enough to untie Jesus' shoes!

ASK:

- Do you like waiting? Why or why not?
- What is something you can't wait to do?
- What do you do when you feel like you can't wait anymore?
