### YOUNGER KIDS ACTIVITY | Big Idea Fish

**INSTRUCTIONS:** Give each kid a blank piece of paper and coloring supplies. Have them create their own fish and cut it out. Have them write the Big Idea somewhere on the fish.

## **YOUNGER KIDS ACTIVITY | Fishing with Nets**

**INSTRUCTIONS:** Soak water beads overnight in a bin. Give kids handheld net to scoop up as many beads as they can and dump them into a bucket.

## **YOUNGER & OLDER KIDS ACTIVITY | Rock, Paper, Cheerers**

**INSTRUCTIONS:** Pair your kids up (or play with them) to play a game of “Rock, Paper, Scissors” against each other, replacing the words with, “Rock, Paper, Cheerers.” Whoever wins the round has to say a word of encouragement to the one who wins. Play a few rounds until everyone wins and is encouraged.

**SAY:** Sometimes in life, things don’t go like we would like them to and we can get disappointed. In those moments, Jesus will encourage us or send others to encourage us!

## **SNACK ACTIVITY | Campfire S’mores**

**SAY:** Jesus sat around a campfire with his disciples and ate breakfast, so today instead of bread and fish, we’re going to have s’mores!

**INSTRUCTIONS:** Give each kid a bowl with small pieces of graham crackers, mini marshmallows, and chocolate chips. Add milk to make s’mores cereal, for kids without dairy allergies.

**ASK:**

- Which part of the s’more is your favorite?
- Have you ever had a campfire before?
- What do you think Jesus and his disciples talked about around the campfire?
