YOUNGER & OLDER KIDS ACTIVITY | Memory Verse Memory Game

INSTRUCTIONS: Print out two copies of the [memory verse printable](#) and cut out the cards. Lay all the cards face down in the middle of the floor. Split into two teams and play the game of Memory with the memory verse cards and see who can get the most pairs. Then, have each team try and put a set of cards in order to make today's memory verse - Micah 7:7!

OLDER KIDS ACTIVITY | Make Room

INSTRUCTIONS: Give your kids four small pieces of paper. Ask them to draw four different things in life that take a lot of their time. Now, play “One of These Doesn’t Belong!” Ask them to remove one thing and give them a picture of a cross to remind them to give up a bit of time dedicated to that hobby/activity to spend more time with Jesus.

SAY: Let’s think about how we can make room for Jesus. Put this in a place in your house where you will see it every morning as you get ready as a reminder to spend time with Jesus!

OLDER KIDS ACTIVITY | Words with Friends

SAY: Make a list of people you know. We talked about how everyone needs a Savior – that includes the names you just wrote down. And don’t forget to put yourself on this list, too! Everyone needs a Savior and being kind to others prepares their hearts to feel the love of Jesus! Talk to God about helping you be someone who makes a way for others to know that they need a Savior, too.

INSTRUCTIONS: Print out the [Words with Friends printable](#). Ask the kids to cut out paper Scrabble tiles and glue them on the board, spelling out three names of the people on their list. Let them get creative in arranging the names by overlapping shared letters.

SNACK | Life Preservers

INSTRUCTIONS: Give each kid a mini powdered donut and a popsicle stick. If you have red icing at home, have them “paint” some red icing on their donuts to create little life preservers.

ASK:

- Have you ever used a blow-up tube that’s shaped like these donuts?
- How do these life preservers help us?
