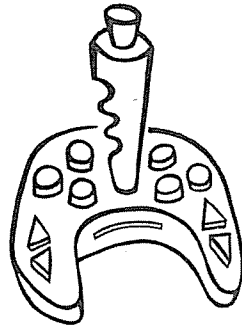


# Stand Firm Situations
