YOUNGER KIDS ACTIVITY | Tick, Tock, TIME!

INSTRUCTIONS: Play a version of "Duck, Duck, Goose," where, instead of "duck" have your kids say "tick, tock, tick, tock," and instead of "goose" have your kids say "Time!"

YOUNGER & OLDER KIDS ACTIVITY | Joseph's Coat Play-Doh Mat

INSTRUCTIONS: Print off a copy of this Play-Doh mat of Joseph's coat and, using various colors of Play-Doh, design a colorful coat for Joseph on the mat! If you cannot print it off, then just have your kids create a colorful coat with their play-doh.

YOUNGER & OLDER KIDS ACTIVITY | Green Eyed Monster

INSTRUCTIONS: Give each kid a handful of green slime or playdough and encourage them to make a little green monster to represent the feeling of not being happy for someone when something good happens to them.

SAY: When someone feels unhappy when something good happens to someone else, we sometimes say that it's because of the "green-eyed monster." Joseph's brothers had their own green-eyed monster come out when Joseph got special treatment from their father.

ASK:

- Why else were they mad at Joseph? (Because of his dreams.)
- Joseph's brothers didn't act nicely because they were jealous. They didn't make a wise choice. But we can choose how we act toward someone when we are feeling jealous.
- Has the green-eyed monster ever shown up in your life? Who have you been jealous of?
 Why?

FOOD CRAFT | Joseph's Colorful Coat

INGREDIENTS:

- Graham Crackers (2)
- Icing or frosting
- M&Ms
- Plate & Knife

INSTRUCTIONS: Gather graham crackers, icing, M&Ms, a plate, and a knife. Lay one whole graham cracker on the plate the body of the coat. Next, break one whole graham cracker

half, then break that piece in half. It will leave you with two small rectangular pieces. Lay these down as the arm sleeves of the coat. Spread icing on the entire coat. Start laying M&Ms on the coat and continue until it's full. You can lay them in any order you like, just make it colorful!

Joseph's father gave him a colorful coat. Even though his brothers took it away from him and had him sent to Egypt, Joseph still trusted that God had a plan for him.
