YOUNGER KIDS ACTIVITY | Pit Stop Party

SAY: Let's celebrate God with a praise party! We can sing and dance to praise God because we love God and because God loves us! We can worship God with our bodies, our words, and our hearts. We obey God by worshiping God. So, let's worship God now!

INSTRUCTIONS: Play upbeat music for the kids to sing and dance along with. Find ribbon or streamers to dance along with!

YOUNGER KIDS ACTIVITY | Spell it Out!

INSTRUCTIONS: Challenge the kids to see if they can use their bodies to make each letter of the word, 'worship'. Help them out by giving them instructions on how they should position themselves!

SAY: What does that spell? Worship! Let's remember to worship God every day!

OLDER KIDS ACTIVITY | It's a Sign!

INSTRUCTIONS: Set out art supplies. Tell the kids to refer back to Philippians 4:8-9 and choose one word they feel best describes God. Give them time to create a piece of art on their canvas around that word.

SAY: In Philippians 4, we read the following words: true, noble, authentic, right, pure, lovely, admirable, compelling, excellent, gracious, and praiseworthy. All of these words describe the God we serve, talk to, and worship today. Let's worship and admire God by making a piece of art that you can take home as your souvenir from today's road trip!

OLDER KIDS ACTIVITY | Ways to Worship Map

SAY: This week we learned that one way we obey God is by worshiping God. But there isn't just one way to worship God! Today, we are going to make a list of ways we can worship God and then choose one or two that we can try this week.

INSTRUCTIONS: Brainstorm different ways <u>on this checklist</u> that we can worship God: prayer journal, walking in nature, singing, dancing, creating art, giving money or items to people in need, etc. Help the kids create a list of ways to worship that they can take home and use as a map on their daily road trip through life!

SNACK ACTIVITY | Pretzel Churches

INSTRUCTIONS: Give each kid some pretzel sticks. Show them an example, and then encourage them to use the pretzel sticks to make an outline of a church before they eat them. Use icing to stick the pretzel sticks to a plate.

ASK:

- What are some of your favorite things to do at church?
- What other things does your family do on church days?
- Do you have any favorite songs you like to sing at church?
