



Quilt Canada 2025 Binding Challenge —Presented by Quilts for Survivors

Goal: 1.6 Billion Inches of Binding

That's right — we're aiming for 1.6 billion inches of quilt binding — enough to wrap around the entire world!

We're calling on quilters across Turtle Island to help us reach this incredible milestone in honour of residential school survivors, their families, and those who never made it home.

♦ Binding Guidelines

- Binding Size:
 - Cut binding strips at 2.5 inches wide.
- Fabric Type:
 - Use 100% quilting cotton fabric only.
 - Solids, prints, and scrappy bindings are all welcome, as long as they do not include restricted fabrics.
 (You can find the restricted fabric list on our website under the FAQ section.)
- Seam Style:
 - Please attach binding strips diagonally (bias joins) to reduce bulk.
 - Iron seams open not to the side for a smoother finish.
- Binding Length:
 - Make your binding as long as possible!
 - Measure the total length in inches and include a slip of paper with the number clearly written and securely attached to your finished roll.

- All binding must be shipped before June 2025 to be counted toward the total.
- Important: Any binding sent to the Quilts for Survivors Studio address will NOT be included in the official challenge total.

O Do NOT send binding with straight pins attached.

Use rubber bands or masking tape to keep your rolls secure.
