Brevard Community Band Announces 2005 Schedule

The Brevard Community Band will have their first rehearsal on Thursday, April 28, from 6:30 to 9 p.m. in the Band Room of Dunham Hall on the Brevard College campus. Musicians who are interested in being a part of the 2005 Season should plan to attend. All reed, brass and percussion instruments are invited to join the band. Rehearsals are on Thursday evenings.

Under the baton of Paul Barber, the band begins its fifth year, and is fortunate in having a number of professional musicians as members of the group. All musicians are volunteers and find enjoyment in bringing concert music to the county.

The first public concert will be on Friday, May 20, from 8 p.m. to 9 p.m. for Relay for Life. The event will be held at the Transylvania County Recreation Building behind the elementary school on Ecusta Road.

On Sunday, June 12, there will be a formal concert at 3 p.m. in Dunham Auditorium of Brevard College. Tickets for the concert will be available at Celestial Mountain Music on West Main Street, Rockin' Robins Records & CD's in College Plaza on North Broad Street, and the Gurley State Farm Insurance Agency in the Forest Gate Shopping Center.

On Monday July 4 the band will present a Special Holiday Program Under the Gazebo on East Main Street beginning at Noon. Following this performance there will be a series of concerts, "2005 Summer Concerts on Main," on Saturdays at 3 p.m. in downtown Brevard. The first of these concerts, will be held July 9 with the Nouveau-Passé Jazz Orchestra. The

BCB will return on July 16, followed on July 23 by the Sweet Mama T & Her Red Hot Sugar Babies. The BCB will play on July 30, and on August 6. The Pyramid Brass Quintet will perform. Then the Brevard Community Band will complete the Saturday "2005 Summer Concerts on Main" on August 13. All of these concerts are under the auspices of the Heart of Brevard.

On Saturday, July 23 the band will present a special concert for the residents of College Walk at 3 p.m. and will also perform at the Lake Toxaway Country Club at 3 p.m. on Sunday, July 31. On Tuesday, August 16 the band will perform their Annual Special for the Connetsee Falls Volunteer Fire Auxiliary at 6 p.m.

The final concert of the 2005 Season will be held in Dunham Hall on Sunday, September 18 at 3 p.m. Tickets will be available at the usual outlets already mentioned. Tickets for both formal concerts are \$5 (\$6 at the door), and children under the age of 17 are admitted free accompanied by an adult.

The Brevard Community Band is a North Carolina Corporation, and holds a 501(c) 3 Tax Exempt Status by the Internal Revenue Service. The band exists by the financial support of many businesses and individuals within the community. Because of this support the organization has been able to offer scholarships to qualified students who are continuing in some form of a musical career.
