It's a story about cultural clashes, familial relationships, and coming of age, set around the "budding" new pot industry with its growing pains, follies, and fun.



THE WORLD

The Hello Cannabis world is set in our nation's capital, Washington, D.C.

With both medical and recreational marijuana legal in the D.C. area, the Go For Green dispensary is uniquely located to serve two colliding worlds – that of the nation's richest and powerful mover and shakers as well as the underprivileged living in some of the toughest neighborhoods in America.

Located in the historic Anacostia district, the dispensary serves a widely diverse customer base where the staff are as diverse as the population they serve.

The Story



THE STORY FOLLOWS DEREK, A RECENTLY HIRED MARIJUANA DELIVERY DRIVER AT THE GO FOR GREEN DISPENSARY LOCATED IN THE WASHINGTON, D.C. AREA.

HE ASPIRES TO OPEN HIS OWN DISPENSARY, AN IDEA HIS LATE US SENATOR FATHER ENCOURAGED HIM TO PURSUE BEFORE HIS UNTIMELY DEATH.
WITH THIS NEW JOB, DEREK HOPES TO OVERCOME HIS PAINFULLY AWKWARD SOCIAL SKILLS AND LEARN THE BUSINESS.

BUT HIS MOTHER SUFFERS FROM HYPOCHONDRIA AND SEES HIS NEW JOB AS A WAY TO OBTAIN THE VARIOUS OBSCURE POT STRAINS SHE BELIEVES WILL CURE HER EQUALLY OBSCURE MEDICAL CONDITIONS. THE PROBLEM IS, SHE HOLDS DEREK'S TRUST FUND MONEY RANSOM WITH HER DEMANDS FOR THE EVER-CHANGING POT STRAIN SHE SEEKS.

IN SEASON ONE, THE STORY COMES TO A HEAD WHEN DEREK TAKES HIS MOTHER TO COURT FOR THE TRUST FUND MONEY. OF COURSE THE JUDGE IS A CUSTOMER DEREK HAS DELIVERED WEED TO, SO HIS RULING IS JUST AS OFF-BEAT AND WACKY AS WE'VE COME TO LEARN THE GO FOR GREEN SERIES IS.



DEREK DEVINE, 31

Derek has a plan. He will open his own dispensary because if there's one thing he knows, it's pot.

His late father left him a trust fund he hopes to tap for his dream. He just needs to learn the business and overcome his social awkwardness, a by-product of losing his father during his formative years.

Derek works on his social skills by cracking jokes and overcompensating his lack of knowledge with an air of importance and knowledge he doesn't actually possess. Now he just needs to learn the retail pot business.

Ahh, but his mother. HER. She foils him at every turn with her insistence upon the ever-changing pot strain she demands he find, and then holding hostage his trust fund allowance until she gets it.

Over the course of the series, Derek begins to make his own way in the world, Through trial and error, and big dose of fake-it-'til-you-make-it, he divests himself from his mother's ransom demands and chain-yanking.

If there's one thing Derek learns, it is he can't be what others want him to be. His journey begins trying to be what others want and ends with a proclamation he won't be, "in a million years."



NANCY DEVINE, 54

When Nancy's husband – Derek's father – died, she began to suffer from unexplainable, reoccurring, and often unheard of, ailments.

As she fought desperately to cure them, a once black stain on their family -- Derek's drug dealing past -- turns into a saving grace for their relationship and her psychological needs.

Derek's job as a marijuana delivery driver allows Nancy to keep her son's attention by asking for obscure pot strains to make her feel better, while giving her a target for her pain – Derek himself.

As the series progresses, Derek begins to sense her manipulation and starts to break away.

Nancy's desperation grows until she finally gives in to his demands for the trust money to start his own dispensary -- by court order.

Don't count on it being that simple.



ALLEN ALLBRIGHT, 33

Allen is dead set on being the savior of alcoholics and addicts.

He comes from a broken home. His alcoholic father left his mother for a younger, just as alcoholic woman, leaving behind a resentful mother who is reminded of her pain by Allen's very existence. Allen is caught in between.

To prove his self-worth to himself and his parents, he is a fire-branded recovery warrior, forever fighting for abstinence.

Allen's project is Derek, who he vacillates between disdain for and unhealthy codependence as the object of his recovery efforts.

As the series progresses, Allen begins to turn his efforts inward, as he can no longer stand his own pain, not to mention, the Derek experiment just isn't working.



ANGELA PODEROSA, 31

Angela is a woman in a man's world. She has ambition, talent, and trajectory. She is a tough boss and equally tough friend.

Her father is a busy senator, widowed when Angela was in college. With the pain of his wife's passing too strong to bear, he has distanced himself from Angela.

Providing for her financially is his way to show her he still loves her, but for Angela, he has abandoned her, when she needs him most.

So, Angela compensates by using her power as a manager and money from her father, to fill the loss of fatherly love.

This translates to the cliché daddy issues. Turns out, Derek is just the right amount of arrogant, stubborn and, well, manipulatable to earn the target of her attention.

As the series progresses, Angela finds herself in some hot water for her actions and must decide if her father issues are worth it.

Eventually, Nancy contracts cancer and faces death's door. This is a natural series ending, their relationship coming to a close.
