Venue of the Conference

The Philippines is an archipelago of 7,641 islands situated east of Vietnam and north of Indonesia and divided into three major island groups - Luzon, Visayas and Mindanao. It is relatively a small country extending to about 2,000 km in length yet over 15,500 km worth of beaches.

The capital city, Manila in Luzon is a coastal and highly urbanized city of the National Capital Region also known as the Metropolitan Manila. Manila is located at the eastern coast of Manila Bay and surrounded by the cities of Malabon and Caloocan on the north, San Juan City on the east and Pasay City on the south. Manila is hot and humid year-round, with daytime temperatures averaging from 19°C to 39°C with January to February as the coolest months while March to May as the hottest months. The seasons lasts from late November to early March and the rest of the year features short intense spells of rainfall.

SMX Convention Manila

Situated at the Mall of Asia Complex in Pasay City, the venue is ideal for international exhibitions, large-scale trade events, industry conventions, and corporate and social functions. Equipped with four (4) exhibition halls, five (5) function rooms, fifteen (15) meeting rooms, the venue offers a total of 17,170 square meters of space that can accommodate 18,000 of audience. Designed by Arquitectonica, SMX Manila serves as a prime example of sustainable development and was built with environmental awareness integrated in every aspect of its execution.
