Horse(s) must have the following before unloading onto Stable property:

i) Up-to-date NEGATIVE Coggins test – if a NY Horse, the Coggins may be dated this year or the year prior – if

an out-of-state horse, the Coggins must be dated current this year.

- ii) Current Rabies vaccination administered by a licensed veterinarian
- iii) Current vaccination against WEE, EEE, Tetanus, and Flu/Rhino.
- iv) If Horse is from out-of-state, must have a current 30-day Health Certificate

#### General Disclaimers

Boarder is responsible for vet, farrier, grooming, medical care, riding, training, etc. Stable will provide extra services for an additional fee. Stable can recommend some vets and farriers in the area if Boarder does not already have one.

The standard deworming schedule for Stable is twice a year and is included in the board. Any other deworming is the responsibility of the boarder.
