#### **Clinical Innovations:**

Shared Medical Appointments to Expand Access to Buprenorphine Treatment at Boston Medical Center (2012-2016) Developed a group therapy and medication management program to allow expanded access to buprenorphine treatment. Worked with social work staff and psychiatry residents co-facilitating sessions that provided group therapy focused on management of substance use disorders (e.g., relapse prevention, drug refusal skills, use of mutual support groups). Attendance was required for participation in buprenorphine treatment and allowed for patients to avoid lengthy waiting lists as well as better utilizing staff and physician resources. Several residents who have participated in the program moved on to start similar programs at other institutions and two papers were published using this program as a model.

Substance Abuse Consult Service The Delaware Psychiatric Center

(2018-2021)

Developed a resident-led substance abuse consultation service for the severely and persistently mentally ill patients hospitalized at the Delaware Psychiatric Center. Worked with counseling staff to expand substance abuse treatment options in the Recovery Mall to include the initiation of Illness Management and Recovery, a manualized treatment. Residents receive direct supervision in the screening for and management of substance use disorders including withdrawal management and initiation of medications for addiction treatment.

DSAMH Bridge Clinics (2019-2022)

Conceptualized, developed and launched three Bridge Clinics, one in each Delaware county, to provide substance abuse and mental health services to any Delawarean regardless of insurance status. Trained peers and clinical staff in the management of acute substance use disorders other psychiatric emergencies and developed algorithms for appropriate interventions including referrals to treatment. The Bridge Clinics operate 24/7 providing services such as treatment referral, peer services, short term therapy and medication management and serve as a continuity clinic for the residency program.

#### **Narrative Report**

I am a graduate of the MGH-McLean Adult Psychiatry Residency Program and the Partners Healthcare Addiction Psychiatry Fellowship. My clinical and administrative experiences span a wide range of settings and patient populations. In my current role as the Behavioral Health Medical Director for the Delaware Division of Medicaid and Medical Assistance, I work with managed care organizations, pharmacies, legislators and policy makers to assure high quality, evidenced based, fiscally responsible behavioral health care is available for Delaware Medicaid recipients. As the Medical Director and Chief of Addiction Psychiatry for the Delaware Department of Health and Social Services Division of Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services, I worked with state legislators, clinical and administrative staff to administer, monitor and expand addiction and other mental health services for the State of Delaware. As Director at The McLean Center at Fernside, Medical Director of Outpatient Psychiatric Services at Boston Medical Center and as Medical Director of First Steps Treatment Center I worked with multidisciplinary teams to assess and treat patients with a broad range of substance abuse and co-occurring psychiatric disorders in inpatient, residential and outpatient settings. Leadership and administrative duties over the course of my career have included overseeing and supervising the daily medical operations and quality of the general psychiatric and substance use disorders treatment services, participation in utilization management, risk management and continuous quality improvement activities and integration of the program I was managing with the clinical, research, educational, fiscal and operational components of the institution. My research interests lie in developing innovative, evidence-based psychosocial treatments for patients with co-occurring substance use and other mental health disorders. I was a McLean Hospital Maria Lorenz Pope Research Fellow and worked to create and pilot a novel integrated treatment for patients with co-occurring borderline personality disorder and substance use disorders using elements of motivational interviewing and mentalization-based therapy. While at Boston Medical Center, I worked with researchers from Northeastern University to study the effects of limited literacy on patient receiving substance abuse and other mental health services. I am involved in teaching and supervision, having developed and taught motivational interviewing and introductory addiction psychiatry curriculums for psychiatry residents. I work individually with residents and medical students to develop interviewing and diagnostic skills and supervise difficult substance abuse cases. I am the editor of the "The Massachusetts General Hospital and McLean Hospital Residency Handbook of Psychiatry" (2010), have designed a flexible curriculum to train clinicians in the effective use of Alcoholics Anonymous as an adjunct for patients with alcohol use disorders, and am a trainer for buprenorphine prescribing. I am the founder and Medical Director of Justus Mental Health, a psychiatric practice in Media, PA.
