Using writing exercises, small group dialogue, discussion, written materials, and role plays, the workshops are designed to create a space for inquiry into current dispute resolution theory and practice.

As mediation and Alternative Dispute Resolution (ADR) have been integrated into the legal system and business practices, consumers and employees are frequently asked to agree to a variety of processes that may impact individual or collective legal rights. For professionals who recommend dispute resolution processes or who are responsible for resolving conflicts, understanding the elements of mediation is essential. These workshops are for anyone looking to increase skills in dialogue and negotiation and to gain new perspectives on addressing conflict.
