Written and directed by dynamic Italian actress and singer Margherita Vicario, *Gloria!* depicts the music-fueled story of an overlooked maid at a Venetian refuge whose hidden talent helps inspire an uprising.

1800. Teresa (rising star Galatée Bellugi, *The Taste of Things*) is a gifted young songsmith who endures Cinderella-like status at the Sant'Ignazio Institute - a religious institution for girls. There, residents are musically trained by stern chapel master Perlina (Paolo Rossi).

One day, a local craftsman gifts the Institute with a modern and immediately distrusted instrument: a piano. Relegated to the basement, Teresa finds it and begins to explore the keys, unlocking her musical abilities and attracting the attention of the girls upstairs. When news arrives of an imminent visit by the new Pope, the college is thrown into chaos. With Perlina distracted, the girls gather secretly, taking turns on the piano where they begin to compose something new and exciting.

## MARGHERITA VICARIO

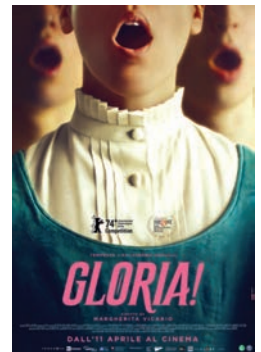

Margherita Vicario (born in Rome in 1988) is an actress, singer-songwriter and filmmaker. During her academic years at the European Academy of Dramatic Art in Rome she produced her debut album as a singer-songwriter '*Minimal Musical*'.

In 2014, whilst acting in films and television series, Margherita also toured clubs and theatres with her first concert show "*LEM LEM - Free Musical Experiments*".

Pursuing careers as both actress and musician, she released her second album "*Bingo*" in 2021. Margherita works with artists such as Francesco Guccini, Vasco Brondi, Elodie, Rancore, and many others.

In 2023, Margherita directed *Gloria!* her first feature film, co-writing the screenplay with Anita Rivaroli and the music with Davide Pavanello.

## PARTHENOPE

The new film from Academy Award-winner Paolo Sorrentino (*The Great Beauty*, *Youth*, *The New Pope*) *Parthenope* is a visually and aurally stunning, decades-spanning romantic drama about a Neapolitan woman named after the mythical siren who once lent her name to the city of Naples.

In 1950, near the Bay of Naples, young Parthenope is born in the Mediterranean Sea, just outside the crumbling castle where she will spend her childhood. As the summers pass, Parthenope (portrayed by breakout star Celeste Dalla Porta) grows into a statuesque and intellectually captivating young woman. She soon learns to navigate the complexities of an emotionally volatile family, the attention of boys, and the expectations of academia, studying under her anthropology professor (Silvio Orlando).

An intoxicating reflection on objectification, and the way people see themselves and others, Sorrentino provocatively shifts between the sacred and the profane. With gasp-worthy visuals from award-winning cinematographer Daria D'Antonio (*The Hand of God*) and fashion design by Saint Laurent, *Parthenope* is a spectacular, challenging and immersive experience.

## MARCELLO MIO

Led by the real-life mother-daughter duo of Catherine Deneuve and Chiara Mastroianni, this new film from acclaimed writer/director Christophe Honoré is a joyous imagining of the lives of a creative family, centring on the legacy of the great Italian actor Marcello Mastroianni.

## THERE'S STILL TOMORROW

### C'È ANCORA DOMANI

The highest grossing film of 2023 in Italy, *There's Still Tomorrow* is a vibrant, moving drama starring Paola Cortellesi (*Like a Cat on a Highway*) in her directorial debut.

Delia (Cortellesi) lives in a working-class community in Rome in the late 1940s - a city divided between the positive thrust of liberation and the miseries of the war that has just ended - with her domineering husband, Ivano (Valerio Mastandrea, *Perfect Strangers*), their three children, and father-in-law.
