First, our resident is expecting her baby girl to be born in mid-April. It's always wonderful to have a newborn in the house! Please keep both of them in your prayers for a safe delivery.

Second, we are getting more inquiries from neighboring counties. Besides Dubuque County, we're getting calls from Clinton County, Delaware County, Linn County, Fayette County, Winneshiek County, and

Des Moines County. So our outreach efforts over the past four years are starting to pay off. There is definitely a need for our program, and as the only maternity home in eastern Iowa we are ready to serve girls from all the counties around here.

Third, we are working with Clarke University students on three different projects: Grant Writing, a Strength Analysis, and Data Collection. The grant writing students did most of the work for our application for the Dubuque Racing Association's grant. The other students are helping us assess our strengths and opportunities for growth, as well as decide what types of data we want to collect so we can evaluate the effectiveness of our program. Social Work Professor, Liz Schuler is spearheading all of it. What a great group of people!

Finally, Clarke's Social Work Department is organizing Abundant Blessings, our internal shop, and planning a Garage Sale on April 27th, so mark your calendars! The store is located in Plaza 20 next to Sun Tan City.

May this spring be filled with new life for all of our supporters! God bless you and God bless Mary's Inn!

OUR MISSION

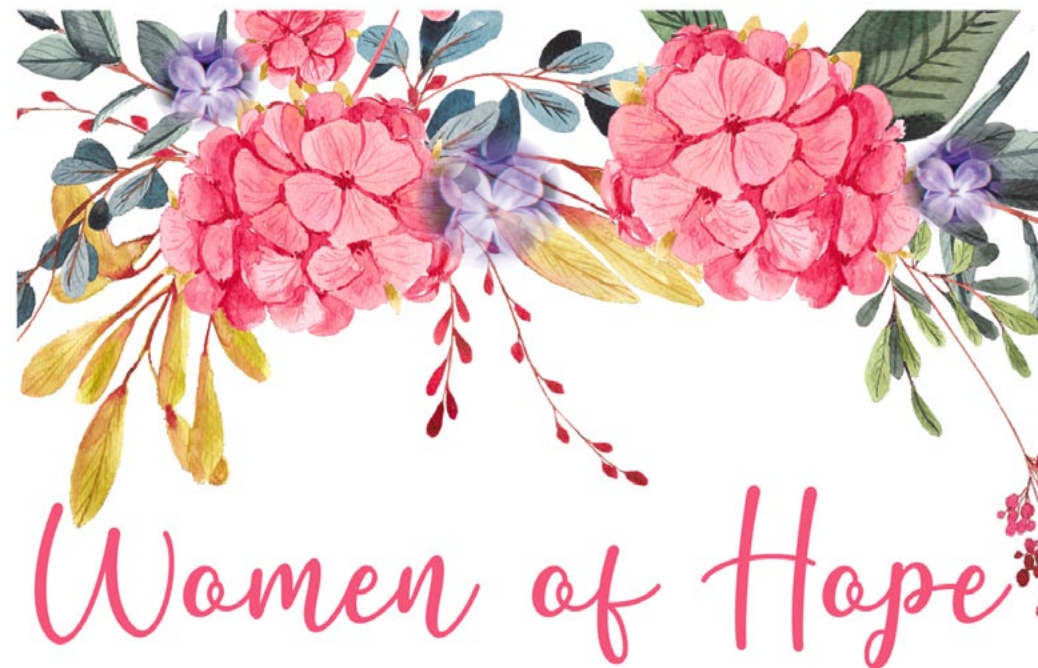

Charitable Giving

The New Tax Law: Our Powerful Response

The recent tax reform bill does indeed reduce some of the federal tax incentives to charitable giving. Reduced incentives might truly discourage some charitable giving. But the bigger question – Will it reduce charity?

Charity is far more than the root word of an IRS policy favoring generosity. Charity, derived from the Latin “caritas,” is love in action. In many of our oldest English translations of the Bible, it is the word used for love in 1st Corinthians 13 that we refer to today as the “love chapter.” The Greek word is agape, or unconditional love.

Charity – the call to love actively – is the very heart of the Word of God and the core of the Gospel. It is God’s charity (love) which is extended, unconditionally, from heaven to earth. It is that same sense that comes to us through the command to “love one another” (John 13:34) and to love our neighbor.

The vast majority of charitable giving is not motivated by the tax deduction. Instead, it is motivated by the mission, vision, and heart, of the work supported.

Robert Louis Stevenson said, “You can give without loving, but you can never love without giving.” Let’s continue to call people to love with their charitable gifts, as we practice charity through our pregnancy help work.
