1199 – The English king Richard the Lionheart was fatally wounded while fighting in France.

1830 – In the small town of Palmyra, New York, E. B. Grandin, an ambitious printer, publisher, and bookshop owner, printed the first copies of the *Book of Mormon*.

1979 – Anwar al-Sadat and Menachem Begin signed the Egypt-Israel Peace Treaty. Brokered by Jimmy Carter, the deal ended a state of war that had existed between the two countries since the founding of Israel in 1947.

During the Third Crusade, Richard the Lionheart was captured by the Duke of Austria. The ransom asked was about two billion pounds in today's money, and its payment required about 25 percent of each Englishman's income for a year.

Diana Ross, born in 1944, is an American Motown legend who found fame as a solo artist and as a member of the Supremes. With Ross at the helm, the Supremes ruled the '60s with hits including “Stop! In the Name of Love” and “Baby Love.” In 1970, Ross launched her solo career with smash hit “Ain't No Mountain High Enough.” She followed with a string of successful albums and acted in films including *Lady Sings the Blues* (1972) and *The Wiz* (1978). Ross has five children, including actress Tracie Ellis Ross, and continues to perform around the world.
