You will need:

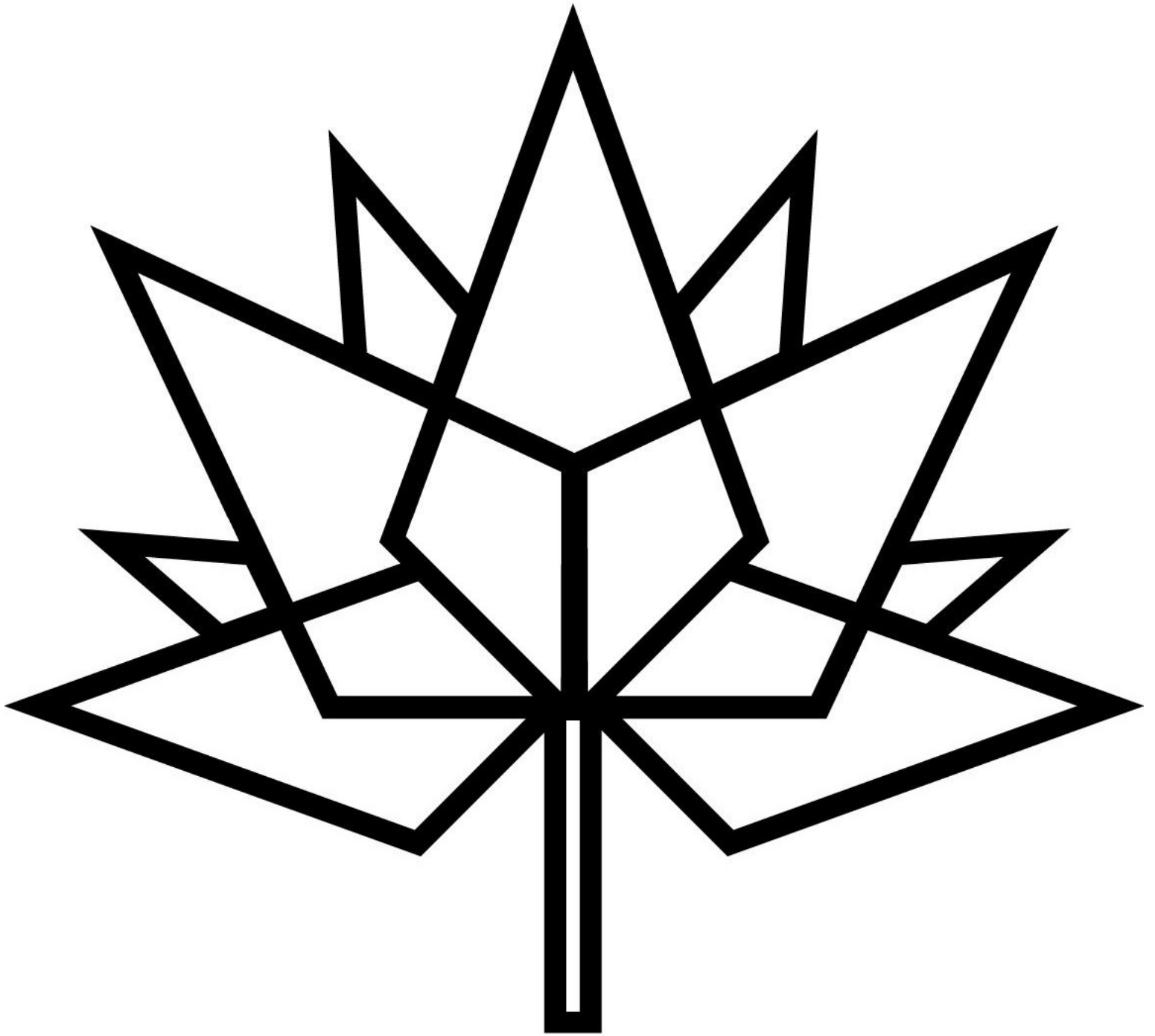
- [Maple leaf background](#) printed on card stock
- [Numbered pattern and color guide](#)
- Scrapbook paper or magazine pages in assorted colors to match the color guide
- Scissors
- Pencil
- Glue stick

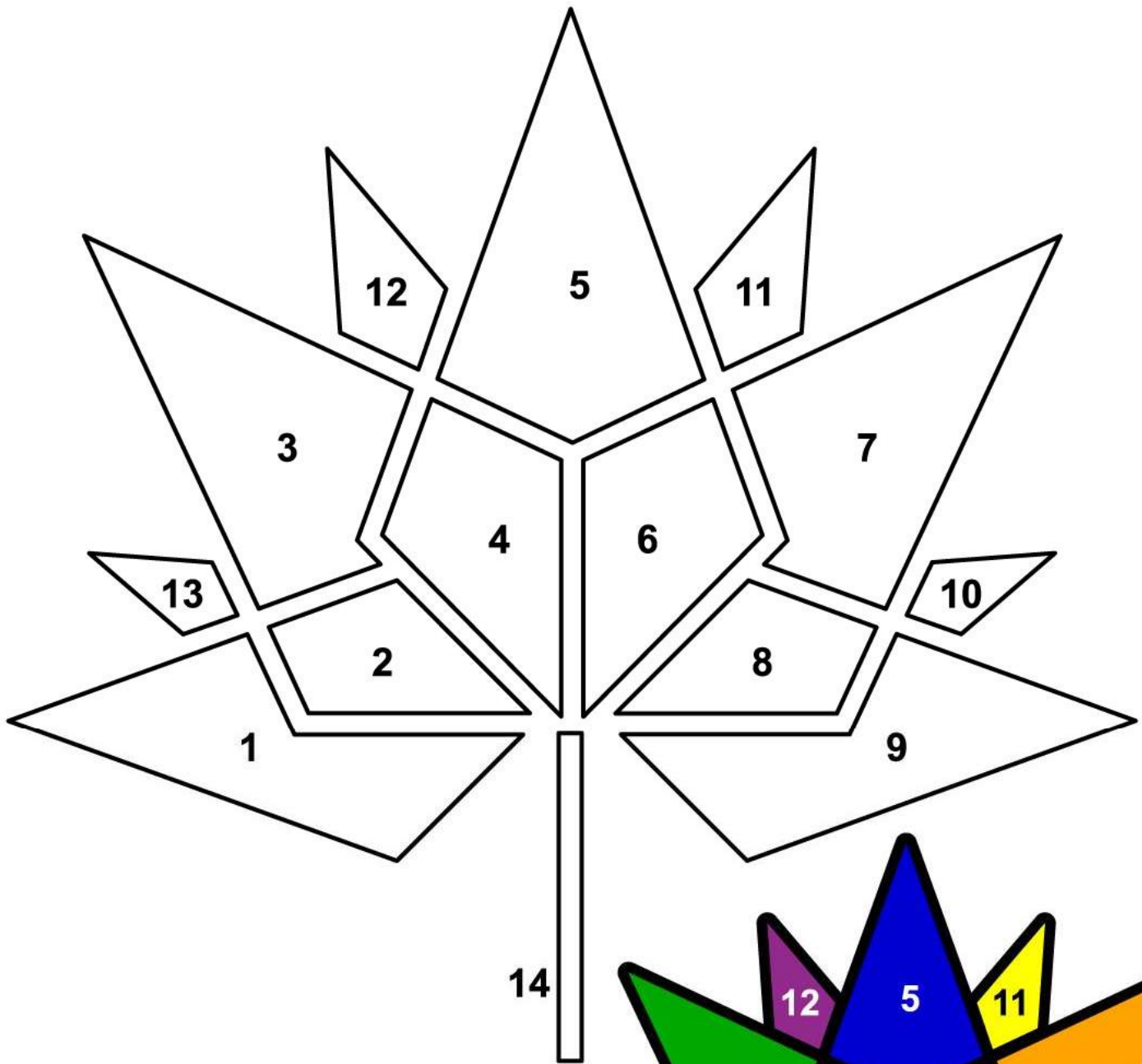


Print a [picture of a completed collage](#) to show participants. Post a copy on your bulletin board to create interest in the activity.

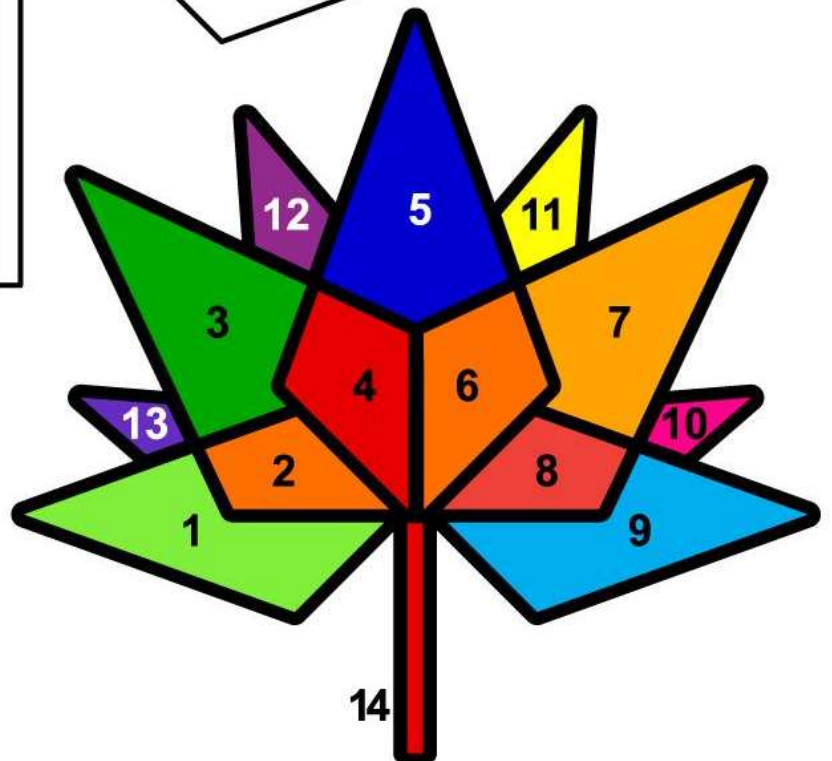
Directions:

1. Cut out the numbered sections of the maple leaf pattern along the solid black lines.
 2. Trace each pattern on a piece of colored paper using the color guide as an example.
 3. Use a glue stick to glue the sections to the black and white maple leaf background.
 4. Sign, frame, and display your collage to show your Canada Day pride!
