first-ever spacewalk. Leonov launched into space aboard Voskhod 2 with fellow astronaut Pavel Belyayev. He spent 10 minutes

outside the ship, tethered to the craft in free fall, taking pictures and making observations.

Vanessa Williams, born in 1963, is an American singer and actress from the Bronx, New York. The multi-



talented Williams made history in 1984 by becoming the first Black woman to be crowned Miss America. As a recording artist, she

released hits including "Dreamin" and "Save the Best for Last," and as an actress, she appeared in films including *Eraser* (1996), on Broadway in *Into the Woods* (2002), and on TV shows including *Ugly Betty* (2006–10) and *Desperate Housewives* (2010–12). Williams married her husband Jim Skrip in 2015, and she has four children.
