**Pete Best**, born in 1941, is an English drummer who played with the Beatles from 1960–1962. He was dismissed from the band and replaced by Ringo Starr just as the group was on the cusp of international fame. In 1995, the surviving Beatles released an album of their early music, including tracks on which Best played, and he received a seven-figure payment for his work. Best has been married to his wife Kathy for 60 years and has returned to music, performing regularly with the Pete Best Band.
