**Mario Lopez**, born in 1973, is an American actor and entertainment journalist who was a child prodigy in dance. Lopez found stardom with the



role of A. C. Slater on the much-loved NBC teen sitcoms *Saved by the Bell* (1989–1993) and *Saved by the Bell: The College Years* (1993–1994). He started working as a child model in local ads in his hometown of San Diego but quickly moved on to parts on television shows including *Kids Incorporated* and an episode of *The Golden Girls*. Lopez appeared on *Dancing with the Stars* in 2006 and is currently an anchor on *Access Hollywood*.
