

# Grocery Ad Scavenger Hunt

You don't have to walk around or pass out difficult clues to host a scavenger hunt. Use the grocery store sale bills and leaflets that you can in the mail and at the store for this fun take on a hunt.

## Preparation

Collect grocery ads from various stores. Make sure they are diverse enough, containing a range of products and prices. I like to make it more challenging by handing out different ads to everyone. Prepare a list of items to be found.

## Scavenger Hunt

Distribute different grocery ads and markers to each resident.

Call out items and have them circle the item and call out.

Write names down on your list as they find the items.

*For example, if I shout out "We are looking for eggs", and Anita says "I found it!" you would write her name next to that item and continue to the next item.*

## Winning

When the game is over, tally who found the most items and award a small prize.

I always award the top three so not only one is getting rewarded. You can also award prizes to the person who found the most difficult item, the fastest finder, etc.

## Example Items to Call Out

- Milk
- Eggs
- Bread
- Sale
- Price under \$3
- Price under \$1
- The most expensive item on your leaflet

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- Chicken breasts
- Hamburger
- Something you'd use to make a cake
- Something you'd use in a big Sunday dinner
